MISTY MOOD tracked in second through the early stages letting MISS ESCAPADE carve out the early splits, let that foe slip away in the stretch but kept to task, finished well and caught the tiring rival in the final yards. MISS ESCAPADE veered in at the start then rushed up to the lead, took the field to the stretch under a confident ride, was roused at the top of the stretch, went clear but shortened strides in the final yards and had to settle for second. HIGHLANDER HONEY settled three wide and content to track the pace to the turn, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths pole, finished with good interest and just missed. CATHERINE BLAZE lacked speed, saved ground and made a late run but was much too late. BOSSADUSU broke well but was not asked to contest the early pace, tracked well behind three wide, launched an early bid from the seven-sixteenths pole, continued three wide through the turn but was unable to factor in the outcome.

HAP HOT dueled inside of STAYED IN FOR HALF from the outset, opened up a big lead at the top of the stretch racing on the left lead and won well clear of the field. STAYED IN FOR HALF dueled outside of HAP HOT from the start, surrendered leaving the quarter pole but continued on well and finished well clear of the third horse. BLING BLING BLING broke slowly then rushed up three wide to chase the pace, finished willingly under steady handling to gain third. CIELO'S KNIGHT raced inside as one of the tracking pair then went evenly in the stretch. NORTHVALE ROAD broke slowly, was the distant trailer to the turn the launched a three to four wide rally and passed tiring rivals in the lane. PHILO BEDDOE tracked two wide a length or two behind the pace then faltered in the stretch. SATURDAY'S GOLD was hustled from the break and was not able to contest the pace but raced close up inside, then started to fall behind after passing the half-mile marker, saved ground to no avail and trailed the field to the wire.

RICH MOUNTAIN veered in and came very close to the rail after the start but secured the early lead then picked up two pursuers at the half, held both at bay through the turn then got away under steady handling and managed to hold off a pair of fast closing rivals on the outside. TOO INTIMIDATING chased the trio in the front of the pack broke away from the tracking group heading into the turn and flattened out in the final furlong. NATURAL HIGH broke in a bit at the start and made light contact with SUMMER HELP, made a bid for the lead leaving the quarter pole but could not get to the eventual winner, flattened out in mid-stretch and had nothing to offer late. GOING TO SANANTONE broke out at the start and mutually bumped with SUMMER HELP, then stalked the pace between horses, made an early bid, weakened on the turn and faded down the stretch.

BALI GIRLEE broke well and got to the front without really being asked, was joined by GIVE EM HAIL GAYLE through the turn but put that rival away before the stretch, extended the lead in the stretch then held off a mild late bid to the outside under steady handling. TAPITSGOTAPISTOL was off slow then raced between horses in the early tracking pack, broke away and launched a bid from the seven-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, started to hang at the sixteenth pole but regained focus and surged ahead into second. BRINGONTHEBUBBLY was well back in the early stages, advanced three wide on the turn then ran on well in the stretch, was closest to the top two with less than a furlong to run, was closing ground on that pair to the wire but ran out of time. IMMA GOING TO WIN broke well and was up with the early leaders for a furlong but caught five wide, dropped back to a tracking position before the turn, relaunched a bid five wide on the turn and went evenly through the stretch while lacking a closing bid. GIVE EM HAIL GAYLE vied four wide early then went clear with BALI GIRLEE late on the turn, struggled to keep pace with that foe into the stretch and flattened out. SHE'S EXTRA raced inside with the tracking group to the turn, got a clean inside trip through the turn then loomed to mid-stretch and weakened late. DAZZLING DUCHESS was off slowly then hustled to join the main pack, steadied slightly near the half-mile pole the changed course to the outside through the turn then was unable to summon a rally in the stretch and finished evenly. RON'S LAVENDER was slow into stride then dropped far, far back early the ran on late and picked up a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. MOONLIGHT GLOW vied three wide for the early lead, started a steady fade after passing the three furlong pole and tired in the stretch. FOOLISH AFFAIR vied between horses through the early stages then struggled to keep up from the seven-sixteenths pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

JACKMAN'S RIDE was hustled from the start and dueled with TWENTYONE N CHANGE through rapid early fractions, put that one away before the quarter pole, opened up in the stretch despite racing on the wrong lead and held clear to the wire. OPTIMAL COURAGE was off poorly then hustled forward, backed off the pace duel passing the half-mile marker, then came back on in the stretch to gain the place. TWENTYONE N CHANGE dueled with JACKMAN'S RIDE through fast early fractions, gave way to that rival near the quarter pole, raced on the wrong lead through the stretch and lost second place in the final yards. AVAILABLE STAR was last away from the gate and dropped well behind through the early stages, saved ground through the turn and was kept to task with a rail run in the stretch but lacked a winning kick. BALSAs broke well and was sent hard but unable to contest the early pace, tracked two deep with OPTIMAL COURAGE into the turn, broke away from that rival at the five-sixteenths pole and went after the leaders but could not summon another gear when needed. CAMPFIRE CREED was one of the first out of the gate but outrun to the turn, chased with some interest down the stretch but was unable to improve.
