SLEW SKIES broke well but took back off the early pace and tracked three wide mid-pack, was coaxed forward with three furlongs to run, loomed three wide leaving the quarter pole and produced a strong finish in the stretch to win clear. STORM MAN hustled into the early pace mix, then took the lead after passing the five furlong pole, was traveling well with a clear lead past the quarter pole, responded when set down in the stretch but could not hold off the winner while saving the place. WILL TAKE CASH broke best and vied three wide for the early lead, then went into a drive to go after STORM MAN after that one pulled clear on the turn, stalled out some in deep stretch but held third. PAINTED LAD outrun from the break, improved position with some belated interest while not posing a serious threat. PRIORITY LANE settled mid-pack five wide early then was sent forward through the turn, chased between horses into the stretch then struggled to keep up late under right handed pressure. KARANTHOS broke well and was very briefly on the pace, dropped back to a staking position three then continued to lose position on the turn, came back on four wide on the turn and oufinished some tired ones in the stretch. RISKY WITH WHISKEY raced mid-pack to the stretch and lacked a rally. MIDNIGHT HUNTER broke slow then veered out and took up after hitting the back end of ALL COUNTRY, advanced inside through the turn, came under a ride after passing the three furlong pole, tried to make a bid up the rail, steadied repeatedly in traffic mid-stretch and could not recover. ALL COUNTRY broke well and chased the pace from between horses, started a steady fade from the three-eighths pole and had little to offer in the stretch.

MIKEL W easily made the lead without being asked, led the way under some pressure from RECKLESS RED, was being confidently ridden approaching the stretch then responded when set down and drew away under a mild hand ride. VINO TEXAS JESS was having to be ridden to keep up early, settled into a good rhythm behind the main pack, came three wide into the stretch and got a seam to run through at the three-sixteenths then finished with good energy to get up for the place. RECKLESS RED pressed MIKEL W two wide to the quarter pole, then was unable to go with that rival in the stretch, kept to task but was caught for the place in the final yards. LUCKY PROMISE got away well, raced close up on the inside, finished willingly up the rail in the stretch but was not good enough. GHOST COWBOY broke out at the start and bothered HE IS HEAVEN SENT then was outrun through the early stages, launched a sustained bid from the seven-sixteenths pole and picked up a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. HE IS HEAVEN SENT steadied at the start when GHOST COWBOY came into the path then was devoid of early speed, trailed well behind down the backstretch, made a belated run up the rail in the stretch to improve position. DREAM SEQ tucked in two wide behind the trio contesting the lead into the first turn, moved to the rail near the thirteen-sixteenths pole but caused RB FASHIONISTA to clip heels, pulled to the lead on the backstretch, came into the stretch a length clear then widened late. WMA BIG BABY was not asked for speed and settled at the rear of the main pack, steadied to avoid the incident late on the first turn, made a four wide bid into the turn, had trouble changing leads but finished best of the rest to gain second. TM PURNCESS was prompted from the start to get forward position, went three wide through the first turn stalked three wide down the backstretch, was asked in earnest passing the quarter pole and finished willingly under steady handling and intermittent urging. AA SWEET VICTORY got away well and vied for the lead through the first bend, turned on to the backstretch contesting the issue between horses, settled into a stalking position to the outside of DREAM SEQ through the far turn then finished evenly through the stretch. MASQUERADESOBIA settled mid-pack from the start, went three wide through the first turn then steered wide late on the turn to avoid the incident to the inside, tried to launch a three wide bid on the far turn but lacked a finish. RB FASHIONISTA settled mid-pack inside, clipped heels when DREAM SEQ took the path turning onto the backstretch, recovered then saved ground the rest of the strip but was unable to threaten late. AA BURNING ASH was unhurried from the break and moved to the rail before the first turn, languished at the rear, far behind the rest of the first turn, was taken to the outside in the clear, went wide through the far turn and stopped. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE FIRST TURN AND THE JOCKEY ON #1 RB FASHIONISTA ALSO LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #8 DREAM SEQ ALLEGING INTERFERENCE FOR THAT SAME INCIDENT. AFTER A LENGTHY REVIEW THE OBJECTION WAS UPHELD AND #8 DREAM SEQ WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED 6TH.
