TX CODE tracked the dueling leaders three wide to the stretch, bid three wide at the three-sixteenths, finished well under steady handling and edged clear in the final years. FORT HOOD pressed the early pace two deep to the stretch, was between horses in the three-way battle down the lane then went on through the final yards with TX CODE but gave way late. TURN NORTH was slow in to stride, went three wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally to gain third. TEXAS HOLDEM raced well off the pace through the early stages then finished with some mild interest in the stretch but could not get to the top pair. TIGERS 'N BEARS was last away and fell behind early, saved ground through the turn and was kept to task, improved position with some belated interest while not posing a serious threat. MY LITTLE PRINCE had good speed from the start and made the lead without being pushed early, led through the turn while taking a little pressure to the outside by FORT HOOD, turned for home with something in reserve, battled gamely to mid-stretch then weakened in the late stages. ESSAY settled mid-pack, saved ground, made a mild bid into the stretch but was unable to improve.

WON MORE TIME veered out to avoid VALHALLA KING shortly after the start, bumped SOLEVO into another rival to the outside, was hustled but beaten threre by DUSTINS DENILE, stalked that one through the turn, then pulled even at the top of the stretch, responded when set down in the drive and finished best by a comfortable length at the wire. ROARING RAPIDS broke out and bumped with CARRY THE FLAG, then was allowed to settle five wide down the backstretch, went two then three wide through the turn, put in a good finish under steady handling to gain the place. SOLEVO broke well but ceded the early lead, tracked inside to the stretch, had the path blocked in upper stretch but finished up well once clear late. DUSTINS DENILE broke a step slow then was hustled to the lead, was being pressed by WON MORE TIME through the turn, cut the corner with the lead but several challengers in close pursuit, kept on well but was outfinished. A LONG TIME got pinballed and steadied a few strides after the start, then was allowed to settle, then moved up to join the two leaders on the turn but lugged out, corrected then came under a ride before the quarter pole, lugged in in upper stretch and went evenly late, losing position near the finish line. KEEP THE KINGDOM broke slowly then rushed to join the pack on the inside, saved ground through the turn then finished up well under steady handling. CARRY THE FLAG broke in an mutually bumped with ROARING RAPIDS, then outrun through the early stages, chased three wide into the turn but could not sustain the bid. VALHALLA VIKING broke well and was being coaxed early, backed off when unable to join the pace battle, dropped to last before the turn and was not a factor in the stretch.
