MAMOOT broke well then initially shared the early lead, backed off heading to the half, then tracked three wide through the far turn, loomed three white at the quarter pole, responded when set down before the furlong marker and drew off under steady handling in a solid debut. FEATHER LAINE broke well and vied inside to the half, took up the chase when COVET pulled away heading into the turn, then even at the five-sixteenths pole, was between horses turning for home, was set down after passing the quarter pole maintained position briefly then was outkicked to the finish by the winner. DADDY SAID I COULD was off a step slow, tracked a few lengths back while under a bit of a ride through the early stages, kept to the inside through the turn, finished well up the rail was in tigh a bitt at the eighth pole and finished evenly. TIME TO COLLECT raced four wide down the backstretch, advanced into contention on the turn, was struggling to keep up passing the five-sixteenths pole, went four to five wide into the stretch then was unable to find the needed late kick. PERSONAL CREED was last away trailed the field into the first turn, struggled to keep up through the turn and tired in the stretch. COVET broke best then went clear on the lead before a furlong while getting some pressure from FEATHER LANE through the turn then joined by MAMOOT three wide on the outside, kicked on when asked into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.

MISS MOZETTI was allowed to settle then stalked behind the pace battle, became stuck behind horses at the furlong pole, altered course to the four path then found best stride late and just got up, unseated the rider on the gallop out, was caught by the outrider and walked back to the winners circle and reunited with the rider for the photo. MIZZ FACTOR was one of the quickest from the gate and vied inside of a three-way battle for the early lead, cut the corner with a slight lead, edged clear in the late stages but was caught in the final yards by the winner. STACY'S PRINCESS veered out after the start but otherwise got away well and vied three wide, was always close up, finished well, but came up short. NANCY LYNN broke well then vied between horses down the backstretch and through the turn, had something left for the stretch, battled gamely but was outfinished late. WONDER WAVE (IRE) chased from mid-pack early, got an inside run through the turn, finished well up the rail but ran out of time in a solid effort. BALMORHEA was off slowly then settled near the rear of the field, kept to the inside and finished with some energy to improve while never a serious threat. LA RONALDA Y G tracked from the middle of the pack, was being coaxed to keep up with the pace early on the backstretch run, finished evenly. DEADLY BEAUTY got away in good order, vied three wide contesting the early pace then flattened out in the stretch. RITZY MISCHIEF hustled from the break but was unable to join the early leaders, dropped back to mid-pack, took up sharply past the three furlong marker, lost much ground then came back on late to improve well after the issue had been decided
