FLY RED BIRD FLY broke off balance and veered sharply inward after the break, was taken up sharply to avoid OBVIOUS CONCLUSION, once settled rushed up to join the main pack, loomed four wide at the quarter pole then flattened out mid-stretch racing on the wrong lead. DOC HENRY RIDGE broke outward but was one of the first from the gate but unable to join the early pace battle, chased five wide down the backstretch then three wide through the turn and was unable to threaten. SPIDERS REVENGE was off slowly and took some time to get into stride, fell

far behind early and was uninvolved in the outcome. SUPER EKATI dwelt in the gate at the start and spotted the field a huge head start, was put to urging early but trailed througout.

BAREFOOT SAMURAI settled two deep with the second flight then was bottled up through the turn while full of run, bided time then got room at the top of the stretch, sprinted clear when roused and was geared down near the wire. BANDERA BLING was unhurried from the start and well behind the field through the early stages, advanced steadily from the half-mile marker, three wide through the turn, bid six wide into the stretch and finished well under steady handling, no match for the winner and just held second over a closing rival to the outside. HARD GOLD was coaxed to the front from the break, secured the rail position while several rivals contested the lead, checked off heels near the half-mile pole and dropped back to last of the group, kept to the inside until the five-sixteenths pole then went around the field, put in a strong rally and just missed getting second in a solid effort. PINKY RING BLING outrun from the break then hustled to race in the middle of the main pack, raced in cover through the turn then could not find the needed response once clear while under heavy pressure. I'M A COWBOY settled inside, took up near the hafl-mile marker, raced in traffic through the turn, ran on some up the rail in the stretch but was not enough. STANS HOME RUN raced on the outside of the main pack close up but off the pace, bid five wide on the turn then went

flat in the stretch and finished evenly. VERACRUZIN broke well and raced between several horses contesting the early lead, edged ahead going into the turn took a short lead under pressure in upper stretch then was overtaken and outfinished the rest of the way. MIDNIGHT HUNTER contested the early pace four wide then weakened approaching the quarter pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch. TALK ABOUT AUTISM was three wide with the early pace scramble to the turn, could not go on from the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. BARBACOA broke well and vied between horses of 4th early lead, dropped off the pace passing the three furlong pole and stopped in the stretch. WITT'S TAQUITO refused to break, was unloaded and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARD INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT NEAR THE HALF-MILE POLE. AFTER A REVEW NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

COUNTRY CAPER came away well and raced close up to the far turn, launched a bid with about three furlongs to run, came four or five wide into the stretch and finished well under strong handling to prevail in a blanket finish. CLIFF DIVER tracked well behind the pace but in the clear down the backstretch, launched a three wide bid from the three furlong marker, came six wide into the stretch and closed relentlessly to just miss. FROM THE HEART unhurried, settled at the rear while keeping to the rail, navigated a clever path through the far turn, avoiding traffic trouble then got a fortunate opening in upper stretch, responded to strong handling but came up short in a very tight finish. IMUA KAI raced inside with the second flight, had to wait for racing room, tipped out to the four path for the stretch run, ran on well under strong handling but was outfinished in the final yards. PROWLING TIGER settled inside with the third flight, stayed to the inside on the far turn, was stuck behind horses until late on the far turn, got clear in upper stretch but lacked a winning kick. SHARP SPARK was two wide near the rear of the field turning on to the main course, ran on late and picked off some rivals with mild late interest while never a serious threat. PAINTBRUSH was last out of the chute, went three wide through the far turn and was kept to task and passed some stragglers in the stretch. CINCO RICHIE raced three wide with the tracking group to the far turn, loomed three wide late on that turn but overrun in upper stretch and outkicked to the wire. SONIC POSSE ranged up to join PAPA RIZZO on the lead coming out of the chute, was a constant shadow to that rival through the early running, ramped up the pressure going into the far turn, came into the stretch with a slight lead but a host of challengers poised for the

stretch run, then was overtaken with about a furlong to run. A. P.'S SECRET was mid-pack through the first half then struggled to keep up late and had nothing to offer in the stretch. PAPA RIZZO was hustled from the break and got the lead coming out of the chute, led the way to the far turn with some pressure from SONIC POSSE, gave way near the quarter pole and had nothing left for the stretch run.
