Following the running of the race there was a stewards inquiry into the start of the race. After review there was no change made to the original order of finish.

STANFORD NORTH away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of RICK'S DANCER in the run down the backside and through the final turn, was collared leaving the turn, and faded late. RICK'S DANCER broke sharply and dueled for the lead two wide entering the first turn, forced the pace from the outside of STANFORD NORTH in the run down the backside and through the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. LOGICAL AL was slow into stride and trailed the field into the first turn, was always well back, and failed to make a serious late impact.
