BOLD ARCH broke sharply and raced to the lead while under a tight hold entering the first turn, controlled the pace in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, held a clear advantage into the lane, and was never threatened late while proving much the best. SOARINGFORTHESUN away alertly and tracked the pacesetter into the backside while racing one out from the rail, rallied two wide into the final turn while in pursuit of the pacesetter, was unable to cut into that lead over the final furlong, but finished willingly two wide in the drive to hold the place. SPACE tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, continued to save ground through the final turn, and closed willingly from along the rail in the drive to garner a share. DIOCLES angled in midway through the first turn, and settled off the early pace while racing at the rail entering the backstretch, rallied smartly two wide into the backstretch, launched a four wide rally through the final turn, and finished five wide in the drive. AUGUST RAIN away well and stalked the pacesetter three wide into the backstretch, launched a four wide rally through the final turn, and finished five wide in the drive while unable to make a late impact. SUNBIRD stalked the leader into the backstree while saving ground along the inside, commenced his bid three wide from between shifting four wide in the drive. SETTECENTO raced into tight quarters in the run to the first turn, before shifting four wide for clear sailing, continued with a wide trip throughout, and had little to offer in the late going. SETTECENTO pulled up on the backstretch and was unsaddled and walked off under his own power.

QUEEN OF ATTITUDE unhurried early while trailing the field into the backstretch, rallied smartly two wide entering the final turn, shifted five wide leaving the turn, and stormed home five wide in the drive to prove much the best. ANOTHERSUNNYDAY settled well off the contested early pace while racing two out from the rail entering the backside, commenced her bid two wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the lane to get up for the place in the final strides. INDYETTA away alertly and pressed the pace from the outside of LICORICE entering the backstretch, continued to battle with that rival in the run down the backside and through the final turn, took the narrowest of advantages into the lane, and gave way grudgingly late. LICORICE away well, and rushed up from along the rail to vie for the lead entering the first turn, set a pressured pace in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, and finished two out from the rail in the rundown the backstretch and through the final turn, go and function bravely from along the inside in the drive. ROSE OF TEXAS broke sharply and stalked the leaders in the rundown the backstretch drive. DON'TPASSTHEPEPPER tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing three wide, continued with a wide trip in the run down the backside, but faded over the final furlong.
