NU SOUP FOR BABY stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, inched closer in the run down the backside, launched his bid three wide through the final turn, swept to the lead straightening for home and pulled clear late. FRASER LANDING broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the outside of STANFORD NORTH entering the first turn, continued to force the issue two wide in the run down the backside and through the final turn, held a slight edge leaving the turn, but was no match when tackled by NU SOUP FOR BABY, but finished two wide in the drive to hold the place. BARBERRY BANDIT unhurried early while trailing well behind the field entering the backstretch, commenced his bid two out from the rail entering the final turn, and found his best stride late while finishing four wide in the drive to garner a share. STANFORD NORTH away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace in the run down the backside and through the final turn, was unable to match strides with his pace rival leaving the turn, and was outfinished in the drive.

CURLIN ROCKS away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a contested pace from the inside of DREAMB in the run down the backside and through the final turn, and prevailed over that rival following a stretch long battle. Following the running of this race, CURLIN ROCKS was unsaddled on the backstretch and walked off under his own power. DREAMB tracked the leader through the first turn while racing one out from the rail, forced the issue two wide in the run down the backside and through the final turn, and closed determinedly two wide in the lane to just miss. KEEP IT COMING stalked the leaders into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, commenced his bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly two out from the rail in the drive to garner a share. GO LENT GO broke sharply and eased off the pace entering the first turn to assume a tracking trip, launched his bid from along the rail entering the final turn, and finished evenly from along the rail in the drive. TIME TICKER away well, but was allowed to settle well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backside, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. ANDALEIGH was unprepared at the start, and got away poorly while trailing the field into the first turn, made a mid race move down the backstretch, but had little to offer late. The steward's conducted an inquiry following the running of this race into the start. Following a review the steward's deemed that ANDALEIGH did not receive a fair start, and ordered a full refund on this horse.

BECKETT'S BEST broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, dictated the pace in the run down the backside and through the final turn, and was never seriously threatened late. PADDY D'ORO away well and was bumped solidly by MAKEITORBREAKIT a couple times entering the first turn, stalked the leader into the backstretch while saving ground along the inside, commenced his bid from just off the rail entering the final turn, and closed willingly two wide in the drive to hold the place. FOOT SOLDIER steadied slightly from between rivals midway through the first turn, before settled three wide entering the backstretch, rallied smartly from two wide entering the final turn, and found his best stride late while finishing three wide to garner a share. BARNEY GOOGLE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and improved his position over the final furlong without ever threatening. GROOVIN' IS BAK away alertly, and steadied early when put in tight quarters at the rail before settling well off the early pace entering the backside, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact when called upon. MAKEITORBREAKIT raced erratically through the stretch the first time while wreaking havoc to a couple of his rivals, chased the pacesetter to the mid point of the backstretch, but stopped badly over the final furlong.

BLUEGRASS LENT away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, continued to set a pressured pace from the inside of EVANDERKEEN in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, held the narrowest of leads into the stretch, and inched clear late under steady urging. SNAP TO IT stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, began to advance three wide midway down the backstretch to loom a danger three wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly four wide in the drive to get up for the place. EVANDERKEEN dueled for the lead from the outside of BLUEGRASS LENT entering the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backside and through the final turn, and closed willingly two wide in the drive and just failed to hold the place. DEAL EM unhurried early while dropping back to trail entering the backstretch, mounted a four wide bid from the back of the pack entering the final turn, and finished with late interest three out from the rail in the drive. NEWHART away well and stalked the contested early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backside, continued to save ground through the final turn, but had little to offer late in an even effort. KIKIS LOVE OF LIFE broke sharply, but steadied when in tight quarters early while bumping with BLUEGRASS LENT, eased into a tracking trip from off the rail entering the backstretch, but weakened over the final furlong.

CAMPTOWN LADY broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, controlled the pace in the run down the backstretch, repelled a bid by NU BLEND leaving the final turn, and drew clear in the lane as much the best. NU BLEND away well and tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied smartly two wide through the final turn to loom a danger leaving the turn, but was unable to sustain her bid late while proving easily second best. NOZOMI away alertly and stalked the leader into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, commenced her bid two wide entering the final turn, and finished from along the rail in the drive to prove best of the rest. MYGIRLLILLY settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backside, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact when called upon. BELLE JOI unhurried early while trailing the field into the backstretch while racing four wide, angled in approaching the final turn, rallied two out from the rail entering the turn, but failed to menace. CHABI settled well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, was always well back and showed little.
