MISS UNION broke sharply and stalked the leaders in the run down the backside while racing one out from the rail, launched her bid two wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in deep stretch to prove second best. VIVA LA VINO raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of ANNIKA'S SONG in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, and gave way grudgingly in deep stretch.

AVE'S IN COMMAND away alertly and battled for the lead from the outside of FOREIGN PROTOCOL entering the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside of that foe in the run down the backside and through the final turn, disposed of his pace rival leaving the turn to take control, and held BIG UNION safely at bay late to prove best. BIG UNION was quite fractious prior to the start, and settled at the back of the pack while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, began to edge closer to the leaders in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide through the turn, tipped four wide leaving the turn, and closed determinedly three wide in the drive to prove second best. KNOPFLER away well, and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while saving ground along the rail, rallied smartly two wide through the final turn, shifted three wide leaving the turn, and finished one out from the rail in the drive in an even effort. FOREIGN PROTOCOL broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of AVE'S IN COMMAND in the run down the backside and through the final turn, was unable to match strides with his pace rival entering the lane, and weakened in the stretch drive.

OVERLY FAST away well and tracked the dueling leaders into the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position through the second turn and in the run down the backside, rallied smartly three wide through final turn, swept to the lead entering the stretch and quickly drew clear as much the best. SLOOP JOHN B away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of TEX HANLEY entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue two wide through the second turn and into the backside, assumed command in the run to the final turn, battled through the final turn from the inside of OVERLY FAST, was unable to keep tabs on that rival entering the lane, but finished willingly from along the inside in the lane to prove second best. TEX HANLEY broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from along the rail through the stretch the first time and through the second turn, struggled to match strides with his pace rival in the run to the final turn, saved ground through the turn, and finished three wide in the lane to garner a share. JERSEYS IMAGE settled at the back of the pack while racing three wide into the lane the first time, continued to race well off the early pace through the second turn and in the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, and finished four wide in the drive while unable to make a late impact. THERE GOES MY HERO settled well off the contested early pace while racing one out from the rail through the stretch the first time, continued to bide his time near the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch, rallied from just off the rail entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon.

PRINCE CAIRO away alertly and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied from just off the rail entering the final turn, slipped through at the rail entering the lane, and closed willingly to get up in time. T'WASBAKKENTHEDAY broke sharply and raced to the lead from just off the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of ANDELEIGH in the run down the backside while racing out from the rail, maintained a narrow advantage through the final turn, and just failed to last while finishing two wide in the drive. CHICKASAW stalked the early leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, was put in tight quarters at the rail approaching the final turn, shifted four wide entering the lane, and finished with late interest to get up for a share. ANDALEIGH away well and rushed up three wide through the first turn to press the pace from the outside of T'WASBAKKENTHEDAY entering the backstretch, continued to force the issue with that rival through the final turn, but faded in the late stages. DONE THAT settled well off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, was always well back and showed little. The rider of DONE THAT dropped his stick soon after entering the lane.

LOVE THE NEST settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, began to advance from along the inside midway down the backside to gain a striking position in the run to the final turn, rallied from just off the rail through the turn, shifted three wide into the lane and closed with a rush to gain the lead late while fending off a late surge by STRAIT OF GEORGIA to prevail. STRAIT OF GEORGIA broke sharply, but was devoid of early speed while trailing the field into the backstretch, launched his bid two wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush four wide in the drive to just miss. FINDING WAYS away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of CASCADE BILLY entering the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backside and through the final turn, disposed of that rival entering the lane, but was outfinished in the late going. CASCADE BILLY away well and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, was unable to match strides with his pace rival leaving the turn, and faded in the drive. ARIKARA stalked the dueling leaders while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, struggled to hold her position in the run to the final turn, raced three wide into the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon.

KITTEN KANDY broke sharply, and angled in to stalk the leader from along the inside entering the first turn, advanced from along the rail to assume a tracking trip in the run to the final turn, rallied along the inside through the final turn, but needed more of a closing response while finishing from between rivals in the lane.
