COUNTERACT away well and stalked the contested early pace while saving ground along the inside entering the backstretch, settled well off the pacesetters in the run down the backside, rallied along the rail entering the final turn, and closed determinedly three wide in the drive to get up in time. WHAT'S SHAKIN settled at the back of the pack while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, launched his bid three wide entering the final turn, and finished best of all four wide in the drive to get up for the place. SET TO SHINE broke sharply and pressed the pace from the outside of STANFORD BAY entering the first turn, assumed command entering the backstretch and quickly crossed over to the rail, maintained his lead through the final turn and into the lane, but was unable to fend off the closers late while settling for a share. INDYETTA away well and stalked the leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, launched her bid two wide entering the final turn, tipped three wide leaving the turn, and closed steadily three wide in the drive to just miss. JERSEY LILLIE broke sharply and tracked the leader into the first turn while racing one out from the rail, forced the issue two wide from the outside of BAKBURNER in the run down the backside and through the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival turning for home, and was outfinished late. ROSE OF TEXAS was unprepared at the start and got away poorly, trailed the field throughout, made an eye catching bid through the final turn, but was unable to overcome her troubled beginning. BAKBURNER away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of JERSEY LILLIE in the run down the backstretch and through the final turn, shook clear of her pace rival soon after straightening for home, and was all out to fend off a late surge by INDYETTA to prevail. PISCO away well and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, launched his bid from along the rail entering the final turn, shifted off the rail leaving the turn, and finished determinedly three wide in the drive to prove second best. JOSE JOSE away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of QUINTECENTS in the run down the backside, disposed of his pace rival to open a clear advantage through the final turn, and was never threatened late while being ridden out in the lane. KYALAM away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue from the inside of FORCED TO RUN in the run down the backstretch, got the better of his pace rival leaving the final turn, and was all out to fend off a late surge by COUNTER CAT to prevail. COUNTER CAT stalked the dueling leaders through the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, continued from along the inside while gaining a tracking trip in the run to the final turn, rallied along the rail through the final turn while awaiting room, shifted three wide for the drive and closed determinedly to prove clearly second best. KRIS'S GOLD unhurried early while trailing the field into the stretch the first time, began to advance from along the rail midway down the backside, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed from along the inside in the lane to get up for a share. GIMLET broke sharply and stalked the dueling leaders through the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, raced into a tracking trip three wide in the run down the backside, rallied three wide through the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. SUNBLAZE settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, pulled her way into a stalking trip in the run down the backstretch, launched her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, shifted off the rail leaving the turn, and closed strongly two wide in the drive to prove best. VIVA LA DIVA broke sharply and raced to the lead entering the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, controlled the pace from the inside of WIRLY GIRLY in the run down the backside, maintained her advantage through the final turn and into the stretch, but was no match when tackled by SUNBLAZE late while proving easily second best. WIRLY GIRLY away alertly and eased into a tracking trip from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, tipped off the rail to chase the pacesetter two wide in the run down the backside and into the final turn, was no match for the top pair late, but battled on to garner a share. MATSQUI settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, raced into a stalking trip from along the rail in the run down the backside and through the final turn, continued to save ground through the final turn, but needed more of a response late when called upon. HIGHER IMAGE missed the break to get away poorly, and trailed the field throughout, posted a mild bid through the final turn, but failed to make a late impact. BAK TO LIBERTY away alertly and stalked the leader into the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, raced into a tracking trip in the run down the backstretch, launched his bid two wide entering the final turn, swept to the lead leaving the turn, and held DUPLICATION safely at bay late to prove best. PAY MY WAY lagged well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the stretch the first time, began to inch closer in the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed four out from the rail in the stretch drive to get up for a share in the final strides. DUPLICATION away well and stalked the leader into the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position into the backstretch, commended his bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed two wide in the drive to prove clearly second best. BUCK'S FIZZ settled off the leader while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, maintained his position through the second turn and in the run down the backside, continued to save ground through the final turn, but failed to muster a late bid while finishing two wide in the drive. BROKE AN BROKEN lagged towards the back of the pack while racing one out from the rail entering the lane the first time, continued from a trailing position in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and closed three wide in the drive while unable to mount a serious late bid.
