TEX HANLEY tracked the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backside, commenced his bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed from along the rail in the drive in an even effort. EYE BE SEEING YOU unhurried early while trailing the field into the backstretch while racing just out from the rail, began to advance from along the inside midway down the backstretch, tipped four wide entering the final turn, and closed steadily four out from the rail in the drive. GROOVIN' IS BAK settled well off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but failed to mount a serious late bid. QUAGMIRE away alertly and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, continued with a four wide rally entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. FOREIGN PROTOCOL broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the outside of BECKETT'S BEST entering the first turn, forced the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backside, was unable to match strides with that rival entering the final turn, and faded over the final furlong.
