BIG UNION dueled for the lead from the outside of RICK'S DANCER entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backside and into the final turn, disposed of his pace rival leaving the turn, held a narrow advantage into the lane, and held TIME TICKER safely at bay late to prevail. TIME TICKER broke sharply, but was taken in hand and allowed to settle at the back of the field entering the stretch the first time, began to advance midway down the backside, launched his bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed four wide in the drive to just miss, while drifting in slightly in deep stretch. TEXAS MOONSHINE away alertly, but eased into a tracking trip behind the dueling leaders through the stretch the first time, held his position in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide through the final turn while awaiting room, and attempted to split rivals in deep stretch, but took up when in tight quarters late. SOMTHING ELUSIVE stalked the dueling leaders through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, dropped back to trail in the run to the final turn, saved ground through the final turn, but needed more when called upon. RICK'S DANCER away well and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, continued to set a pressured pace in the run down the backside and into the final turn, was unable to keep tabs on his pace rival leaving the turn, and weakened in the late stages. Following the running of this race there were two rider claims of foul. The rider on Texas MOONSHINE lodged claims of foul against the rider's of both TIME TICKER and BIG UNION.
