APPREHEND settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, moved into a stalking trip two wide through the second turn, drove up between rivals to assume command in the run to the final turn, was quickly overtaken by RUN RUDOLF entering the lane, but battled gamely three wide in the drive to hold the place. LUCKY FORCE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, bided his time at the back of the pack through the second turn and in the run down the backside, rallied smartly four wide through the final turn, and closed willingly three out from the rail in the drive to garner a share. WHAT'S SHAKIN settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the lane the first time, saved ground through the second turn to race into a stalking trip, rallied along the rail entering the final turn, was forced to steady when in tight quarters leaving the turn, losing all momentum, but closed willingly two wide in the drive.
