BUCK'S FIZZ unhurried early while trailing the field into the backstretch, mounted a two wide bid entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the drive to get up for a share. KNOPFLER settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, advanced into a striking trip from along the rail midway down the backstretch, got bottled up slightly behind a tiring rival before mounting a rail run through the final turn, and closed steadily from along the rail in the drive. QUAGMIRE stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but was outfinished in the late going. DEPUTY'S DANCER broke sharply and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied smartly two wide through the final turn, but came up empty in the stretch drive.
