SWISS SLANG brushed with a rival at the start, raced in the four path and lacked a late bid. MAN IN THE CAN was clear early and gave way near the quarter pole. KING ICE improved position late. PRESIDENTIAL was brushed at the start, raced in the three path and faded. BACKGROUND was not a factor.
