DAZZLING tracked the pace from the two path through most of the race and rallied out from the three path into the stretch and drifting to the inside while inching clear then held on from a rapidly approaching opponent. CHEROKEE PURPLE was slightly bumped at the break and settled to being off the pace along the inside rail and saved ground, then approaching the upper ran up the inside then tipped out mid-stretch while gaining on the leader but was just short at the wire. JAZZ QUEEN broke slightly outwards and brushed a rival while gathering it's stride then dueled for control of pace from the two to three path for most the race, then took command in the upper stretch shifted to the inside but gave way late and weakened while just holding the show award. SWEET JEN broke inwards and bumped a rival to the inside then rushed up in stride and dueled JAZZ QUEEN for control of the pace from the inside, then kept on while entering the deep stretch but weakened while drifting towards off the rail. RUMBELIEVABLE raced in the mid-pack through the three path for most the race and came out six wide into the stretch with a mild rally but was outfinished for the minor awards. DOLLY PARTIME saved ground on the inside towards the back half of the mid-pack then tipped out five wide into the stretch but lacked a final kick and settled back. UPSTART EMPRESS broke outwards and bumped IN A DAYDREAM to the outside then tracked the pace after shifting to the inside, kept on to the upper then steadily weakened from the four path after the bend. BY HER DECREE stumbled a step out of the gate then settled into stride and chased the pace from the inside then swung out

off the bend to the six path and weakened in the home stretch. IN A DAYDREAM broke halfway in the air and was bumped from inside to outside and raced off the pace through the two to four path around the turn then angled out about eleven wide to be widest in the upper but needed a kick. COUNTTHETRUE was brushed at the start with no consequence before settling into stride a couple lengths off the pace and chased from the three path and came out about five wide in the upper while making a mild stand then faded into the seven path. NU WHY ME raced at the rear of the pack in the two path and swung out about nine to ten wide in the upper stretch but made no bid. CLASSIC SONG broke sideways facing the outside and was slammed to the inside then settled off the pace from three to four wide but made no attempt to rally.

CARAGOGO took early command, set a moderate pace from the inside into the turn, kicked clear and kept to task in the stretch and held sway to the wire. GRAND PREMIERE crowded at the start and last away from the gate, made a steady gain outside of rivals, asked three to four wide to upper stretch, was gaining on the winner late but couldn't reel that one in and held safely for second. OLLIE LUKE OUT shuffled back away from the start and lacked early speed, trailed to the turn, swung widest to upper stretch, finished well in the late stages and was a clear third. TEND TO YOU close up in the early stages, stalked the moderate pace to the turn, outkicked into upper stretch, couldn't find more into the final stages and weakened. DON'S WINNER broke out and bothered an outer rival, was forwardly placed to begin and tracked the early pace from the outside, settled in the second flight into the turn then chased from the two path into upper stretch, lacked a response in the drive and failed to threaten late. PARNASSUS settled while saving ground, was well placed into the turn, kept an inside path to the stretch and did not factor late. WAN DALE allowed to settle early, coaxed from the three to four path into upper stretch and did not offer a late bid.

MALIBU SMART stalked the pace from the two path through the early stages of the race and swung out widest in the backstretch coming up the hill before closing back to the three path on the far turn then was finally coaxed at the bottom of the turn before tipping to the inside and drew well clear in the stretch. CALAMITY bumped to the outside at the break and raced mid-pack on the inside through the first turn then shifted into gear coming through the backstretch and dueled the leader in hand then took command in the upper end of the stretch but weakened in the deep drive and settled for the show award. MAMBO QUEEN settled back early and teetered between the two path and inside then was put into encouragement while entering the upper stretch and tipped out five wide and forced OLD FASHINONED GIRL to be taken up briefly with a bump and showed some kick in the deep stretch but was too late. AGIA MARINA broke to the outside and bumped into CALAMITY then settled close up behind the pace on the inside and continued on to the stretch and attempted to bid but needed to find kick in the stretch. STREETWHEREYOULIVE was off slow at the beginning and settled at the back of the pack along the inside then swung out far in the stretch but had no kick left while making up some ground. HOW'S AL TODAY well placed early on while settling in the second flight, tucked to the two path into the turn, angled to the four to five path into the drive, was full of run into the final furlong, took command and kicked clear into the final sixteenth and won in hand as much the best. BATTLEFIELD HERO settled while saving ground early, advanced from the inside nearing the quarter marker, bid between rivals into the stretch, was no match late for the winner but was a clear second. TRIM CASTLE sent to contest the early pace from outside of NEVER SLEEP, pressed that rival through solid fractions into the turn, dueled to the quarter marker then vied for the lead into the lane, couldn't keep pace with the top pair late but held well in the end for third. CRYSTAL RIVER allowed to settle in the early running, coaxed outside of rivals along the turn, lacked a response two to three wide to upper stretch and did not make an impact in the final stages. ROCKY JOY rushed up to the front and set the pace while shifting to the inside rail and showed the way under pressure then inched clear in the stretch and held sway to prove best. MIRACLE MARK broke outwards at the break and bumped a rival hard then settled off the pace close to the back in the two path while shifting out four wide mid-way down the hill, then swung out in the upper and came under strong encouragement and surged past most the field but was just shy of the win. REPENTLESS had a little stumble at the break then got positioned mid-pack along the inside and saved ground through most of the race before steering out far right before the final turn towards home and made a big late rally and just got the show award. GYPSY ART raced off the pace through the four path through the turn then circled the field while being put under a drive in the upper and looked like a clear third best but was outkicked from an approaching rival. CAPANAPARO bumped into FLAT OUT BLESSED at the start then settled up behind the leaders and tracked from the inside then weakened slightly coming down the lane but finished evenly in the stretch.
