QUIBLER raced off the pace about the wide coming on the hill then tipped out nearing the upper and came up between rivals and started it's rally before shifting closer to the inside and meeting the leader then kicked clear in the stretch and proved best. FIFTH PEG was bumped at the start of the raced and settled into position in the third flight between rivals racing two to three wide and bumped with KAKI briefly going sideways nearing the bottom of the hill, then showed some kick entering the upper trying to find room angling in then tipping back outside and kept on just outfinishing a rival for the place award. SOCK MONKEY tapped FIFTH PEG from the jump and was bumped again from the outside while leaving the gate before settling near the back on the inside, then mid-way coming down the hill was close up on a rivals heels and steadied then angled out coming into the upper about four to five wide and angled out again deeper before making a late rally. TODAY ISA GIFT shifted up early on and assumed command coming up the hill from the inside and set a controlled pace then inched clear in the upper while coming slightly off the rail but needed more in the deep stretch. KAKI was brushed at the start and raced in the third flight about three to four wide and bumped with FIFTH PEG mid-way down the hill and kept on in the upper but was just missing punch in the stretch. LA NOCHE NEGRA settled mid-pack four to five wide off the rail on the outside of the field and tipped out widest coming off the bend and finished evenly while tipping towards the inside. LILY ISABELLA pressed for command early on from the four path and continued on with the leader TODAY

ISA GIFT, but lacked a response in the stretch and faded. CHAMITA was forwardly placed early and settled back and tracked the pace from the four path around the hill then tipped towards the inside while weakening in the stretch. CAPODOST was brushed at the start and settled into position between rivals tracking from the two path, then tipped out a little coming into the upper but faltered in the drive. ZARZUELA raced in the mid-pack on the inside rail and came out a bit entering the upper but had no kick in the stretch. HIPS OF A LADY broke outwards brushing with the gate before colliding with it's inside foe then settled into stride off pace in the two path and tipped out a bit coming into the upper but was no factor. SHAYS GRAY kept up an early pace off the break then settled a couple lengths back along the inside and tracked the pace for the remainder of the race before tiring out in the upper.

MARCINKOWSKI away in good order, vied for the early lead then took command to the first turn, made the pace into the backstretch then dictated terms into the far turn, dug in when challenged into upper stretch, repelled the runner-up into the final sixteenth and held well late for the win. EPISIST unhurried while saving ground early, advanced between rivals along the backstretch, angled out into the far turn then roused four wide for the stretch drive, loomed into the lane, had her bid turned away by the determined winner but stayed on to be a clear second. DON'T LOOK NOW settled midpack, advanced two wide into the far turn, bid three wide to upper stretch, couldn't keep pace with the top pair into the final furlong but held well late for third. ELIDA'S ANGEL (IRE) settled between runners early, advanced while saving ground along the backstretch, kept an inside path to the far turn then shifted out, needed more in the stretch drive and was outfinished for third. ROILING vied for the early lead with MARCINKOWSKI then ceded the front, tracked the pace while saving ground into the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn, lacked the needed response when called upon into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. DAD'S TWO SENSE hustled to be forwardly placed early, tracked the pace from the second flight into the backstretch, went up to prompt the pace into the far turn, couldn't find more into upper stretch then gave way in the drive. UNA QUAEADAM settled outside of rivals in the early stages, unhurried to the half-mile marker, couldn't keep pace into the far turn and did not factor in the stretch. BOUJEEONABUDGET close up in the early stages, took back and saved ground into the first turn, dropped back to trail after a half-mile, trailed to the far turn and was outrun the rest of the way. MRS CHOFIS hard to load, veered out at the start and was last away from the gate, wide into the first turn, pulled to be close to the pace at the half-mile marker, lost position with six furlongs to go and had little left in the stretch drive.

BLAST FURNACE bobbled after being bumped at the break and pulled ahead of the pack early and set the pace from the inside clear from the rest, then kept on and inched further away in the late stages and was a clear winner. BOURBON FLIGHT opted to race off the pace about two to three wide on the hill then tipped out off the bend crossing behind multiple rivals and made a big rally as the widest contender and came up late for the place award. WHITE TIGER came in a bit at the start and bumped a foe then settled into the mid-pack around the hill in the four to five path and showed some kick coming through the upper and into the home stretch then vied late between multiple rivals and was just shy of the place award. GOLDEN CHANNEL shifted ahead of the pack shortly coming up the hill and chased the pace from the two path to the inside and briefly dueled with CLEAR THE BEACH in the upper stretch and vied between multiple rivals in the deep stretch but was outkicked at the wire. NEW PURPOSE settled mid-pack early then moved up to be forwardly placed, tracked the pace to the turn, took command two wide into upper stretch, kicked clear at the furlong marker then drew away late while in hand. DOVETAIL lost her path at the start and was off slowly, advanced from the inside into the turn, got caught in tight between runners passing the half-mile, chased from the inside to upper stretch then angled out, couldn't impact the winner into the late stages but closed willingly for second. SHOULD'VE rushed up and set a pressured pace a bit off the rail in the two path and kept on to the upper and kicked clear from it's pressuring rivals and held sway to the wire. MACKINAC tracked the pace from the inside and saved ground through most of the race before angling to the outside of SHOULD'VE and making it's bid quickly approaching on the leader but hit the wire before the task could be finished. LIT SHIP stalked the pace early from the four path then settled back a couple lengths coming down the hill before tipping out nearing the stretch and making a rally from the outside but was just short at the wire. JUST BUY IT sent for the early lead, showed the way from the inside into the turn, met the bid of HE'S MY KIND into upper stretch, dug in while holding that rival at bay into the drive, was unyielding to the final sixteenth, denied the runner-up in deep stretch and held for a game win. BAYFRONT rated nicely off of the early pace, gained ground two then three wide nearing the half-mile, bid three wide to upper stretch, gamely battled into the final furlong, was denied for the win in deep stretch and held for the place honors at the wire. HE'S MY KIND prominent early, stalked the pace two wide to the half-mile marker, dueled on even terms with JUST BUY IT into upper stretch, vied between foes into the final furlong, couldn't find more to the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the win and place, while well clear for the show. CLOCK TOWER was forward early and opted to track the leader from the inside and save ground through the hill then came under encouragement exiting the upper and shifted into a duel, brushing and bumping with RUNNIN' ROCKET through the stretch then pulled ahead just before the wire as a clear victor. RUNNIN' ROCKET took command of the pace early on and shifted to the inside heading up the hill then felt some pressure mid-way down the bottom before inching clear of the pack then battled on in a duel with CLOCK TOWER entering the stretch and was passed up and settled for the place award grudgingly. JADED was bumped at the start and remained at the back and saved ground then came up through the inside and made a strong rally then tipped out entering the stretch and vied between rivals and was just up by a head bob. ROOSEVELT raced towards the back of the pack from the three path and dropped back a bit before tipping out further and coming under coercion then took aim at the leader from the outside and surged, vying with the top two in the deep stretch but just lost the bob to the winner. JOB raced up early and forced it's way to the front and inside and dueled for pace and took command

then kept on to the stretch while inching away slowly but was caught and outkicked. FERROUS was positioned in the middle of the pack two wide off the rail and angled out entering the upper stretch and circled weakening rivals while making an effort and improved well but was no match for the top three finishers. BEACH SANDALS stalked the two leaders from the four path throughout the big turn and kept close to JOB coming down the upper but was empty in the final furlong. INTERMEDIATION was up early with the front of the pack and had to steady back nearing the top of the hill then tracked the pace from the inside and kept on but had no kick in the stretch. ARSENAL STAR tracked the pace three wide early on then shifted to the two path coming down the hill but needed kick in the stretch. TRAVELING BANKER was void of early speed and raced far off the pace along the inside to two path then tipped out a bit coming into the upper and finished with a mild improvement. ROYCES LAW settled off the pace in the four path for most of the race and made a mild gain in the upper but was no real threat. CANDY FREAK broke outwards and bumped JADED then coming around the hill dueled the leader from the three path and weakened a length turning towards home and faded back in the stretch. LOST IN THE FIGHT settled back along the inside and became no menace when entering the upper stretch. CLEVER HEIST settled at the back towards the three path and angled out a bit in the upper but tired out.
