MONIQUE EN VOL was unhurried from the break and settled off pace between the two path and inside then circled COMPASS SIXTY in the upper after coming under a drive and inched clear in the stretch to prove best. VIAGGIO brushed with VELVET CROWN at the start and raced towards the back in the four path then tipped out coming into the upper and vied from the outside and bested the rest but needed more to best the winner. MIDDLEMIST was a step slow at the break and was rated back while coming to the inside then chased the pace down the hill and angled out nearing the quarter pole four wide and brushed into LOVE LINE then vied in the stretch and just got the show award in the final yards. LOVE LINE was up early half a length behind the leader and settled back while shifting out a bit to be three to four wide around the hill then tipped out into the upper while coming under coaxing about five wide and vied between rivals, briefly being in the lead but ultimately being outfinished in the deep stretch. MY BLUE HEAVEN followed the lead closely through the early stages and stalked coming up the hill then shifted up and dueled for command with COMPASS SIXTY from the three path and briefly passed it's rival but weakened in the stretch. ATAYA was a step slow coming from the gate and raced off the pace from the three path and was between rivals coming down the hill but made no bid in the stretch while passing tiring rivals. VELVET CROWN brushed with a rival at the break and settled towards the back in the three path coming around the hill but weakened after entering the upper. COMPASS SIXTY set the pace early and shifted to the inside with one other contender about a length back then dueled with MY BLUE HEAVEN coming down the hill before fading entering the stretch. NO SPLIT TIMES WERE AVAILABLE FOR THIS RACE.

MAJIK MOONEY allowed to settle, coaxed two then three wide nearing the top of the lane, angled inside and took command into the final furlong, dug in late and held well in deep stretch to prevail. CASTLE PINES crowded a bit by an inner rival, was well placed while three wide early on, tracked the moderate pace three to four wide nearing the half mile pole, set down to upper stretch, finished well in the late stages and missed for the win, while holding for the place. OVERTIME BONUS broke out at the start, showed good early speed and attended to the moderate pace two wide into the turn, pressed to the half-mile marker then vied for the lead to upper stretch, battled three wide into the lane, was outfinished in the final sixteenth but held safely in the end for the show. APRIL FOOLS off slow then crowded at the start, trailed to the turn, advanced between rivals into upper stretch, was caught in traffic into the final furlong, angled out into deep stretch but couldn't muster the needed late response. YALTA forwardly placed early on while outside of rivals, coaxed four then five wide nearing the half-mile marker, swung widest to upper stretch then couldn't find the needed response to the final sixteenth. SMOKE TRAIL a bit slow into stride away from the gate, settled in the second flight, chased from the two path nearing the half-mile, lacked the needed response at the furlong marker and flattened out late. RUPP showed good speed from the gate and took early command, set a moderate pace into the turn, showed the way to the half-mile marker then led while off of the rail into upper stretch, dug in approaching the final furlong, couldn't hold off oncoming rivals in deep stretch and faltered late. POP AND LOCKE off a bit slowly to begin, settled while saving ground to the turn, kept an inside path to the half-mile marker then saved all of the ground to upper stretch, couldn't find more at the furlong grounds and failed to threaten late.

IDRATHERBEBLESSED stalked the pace from the break two wide then shifted up a bit heading up the hill and dueled GILDED CRAKEN remaining two wide before pulling ahead in the upper then lugged out entering the stretch and held off two other rivals in the deep stretch. ESMARK bumped with ANDTHEWINNERIS at the start and raced towards the back coming four wide around the first turn then settled into the third flight three wide off the rail and swung to the outside in the upper and was bumped by ANDTHEWINNERIS again nearing the furlong marker but kept on and held out for the place award. ANDTHEWINNERIS was bumped at the break and settled back early then advanced along the backstretch and chased the pace from the top of the hill in the two path, kept on in the upper and swung out bumping with ESMARK nearing the furlong marker then had trouble finding enough room in the deep stretch. WAR OFFICER settled towards the back along the inside through the early stages then came out a bit while heading up the hill and being

positioned in the third flight, was between rivals heading down the hill then tipped out in the upper and improved in the stretch while being no match for the top finishers. RISK MANAGER chased the pace early from the three path on the outside of SUGOI then settled back a bit heading up the hill and came to the inside but lacked a rally in the stretch. SUGOI was up early along the inside and chased the pace through the early stages making a little gain on the backstretch then weakened heading down the hill and tired out in the stretch. LINCOLN HIGHWAY raced off the pace from the two path and shifted to the inside at the crest of the hill and got distanced from the pack then made up ground in the upper but was still no factor. GILDED CRAKEN sent for the pace early while coming three wide around the first turn and inched ahead of it's contenders coming down the backstretch before being closely pursued again up the hill, then shifted to the inside and dueled with IDRATHERBEBLESSED coming down the hill and faded into the upper. RED SQUARE tracked the pace from the two path through most of the race before shifting up nearing the final furlong and taking command then inching away running through the stretch to prove best. BLAZING TIGER was rated back a couple times coming around the hill while being on the inside and got bumped by PUTEKETEKE coming off the bend and was steadied hard by the rider after throwing it's head in the air then continued on shifted up behind the top two leaders in the upper and tipped out near the final furlong making a strong bid but finished on even terms with the winner after being a couple lengths away. PUTEKETEKE settled into the mid-pack in the two path and bumped into BLAZING TIGER nearing the quarter pole then dropped back in the upper and circled the field from the outside while making it's rally and was just up for the show award. JUBILEE PARADE send for the lead after the break and shifted to the inside and vied for pace with two other rivals and kept on, lasting the longest between the trio but ultimately weakened a little before the wire.

POSSIBLEMENTE vied for the early lead then ceded the front, attended to the solid pace two wide to the half-mile marker, dueled MONDOGETSBUCKETS into the stretch, shook free of that rival approaching the final sixteenth and held safely over the oncoming runner-up. NOTABLE EXCHANGE was positioned in the mid-pack at the break and hugged the inside rail around the hill before coming off a bit opening up the inside rail for RIPASSARE nearing the five sixteenths then made a rally in the stretch and held the show award but was no match for the top two. RIPASSARE brushed the gate at the start and raced close to the back along the inside then advanced up nearly the quarter pole and tipped out about three wide passing the final furlong while making a late rally and improved. ATHALIAH was bumped to the outside and brushed with TALIESIN at the break then settled towards the back of the pack in the three to four path then swung out coming off the bend into the five to six path and made a mild improvement but needed more. I'M MO JOKE brushed with ABIENTOT then shuffled up quickly and set the pace along the inside a length clear from the pack and came under some pressure heading into the final quarter but faded after passing the last eighth. YELLOW SUN DRESS broke

outwards and raced off the pace at the very back of the field along the inside then tipped out late in the stretch but lacked kick. TALIESIN chased the pace from the two to three path around the hill then began to weaken after passing the quarter pole. AIR ONE raced in the mid-pack four wide off the rail but faded while approaching the quarter pole. LUCY MCGEE broke outwards and bumped into ATHALIAH at the break then settled into stride and was placed mid-pack between rivals coming three to two wide around the hill and tipped out in the upper stretch but tired out.

STIR off slow, settled inside, weaved through stretch, dug in late, impressive debut. AGEEBEA BEACH settled outside, asked six wide upper stretch, finished well, missed for the win, clear second. GREAT KERRY LEE settled second flight, traffic nearing the half-mile, angled out to upper stretch, bid three to four wide for the drive, outkicked, clear third. COWGIRL PARADISE settled to the turn, angled four then five wide to upper stretch, needed more late but improved position in the drive. TOOCOOLFORSCHOOL close up to the turn, took back then tracked to the half-mile marker, bid four wide into upper stretch, led at the furlong grounds, couldn't hold on to the final sixteenth and faltered late. FREGATA broke alertly, vied for the early lead then contested the pace from the inside into the turn, shook free to upper stretch then led to the quarter marker, vied to the three-sixteenths then weakened in the drive. WONZEE

WEATHER settled outside, four to five wide to the half-mile marker, maintained a wide trip to the stretch, couldn't threaten the leaders late but improved position in the final sixteenth. SUMMER DATE settled inside, loomed inside upper stretch, caught in tight nearing the furlong grounds, shifted out approaching the final sixteenth and flattened.
