HEMINGWAY set the pace from the inside at a collected manner and began to draw away from all rivals shortly after turning into the straightaway and finished under simple hand urging while being clearly best at the wire. EPIC ROLL was between rivals early on leading up the hill then shook away from the rest of the pack with the leader and stalked from the two to three path heading down the turn then kept on but was no match for the winner while holding a clear second best. BEST SCREENPLAY settled into the mid-pack along the inside and saved ground up until the three eights marker then tipped out heading into the upper and rallied making up ground to get a clear show award but was well behind the next award. ENCHANTING CAT bumped with BANYAN at the start and stalked the leader from the break about five to four wide up the hill then chased after dropping back a couple lengths but was well behind in the upper just besting the rest. BANYAN bumped ENCHANTING CAT at the break and raced towards the back of the pack in the three path then had a mild kick in the deep stretch but was no real threat. MEGACENTER brushed the right side of the gate while being off slow and raced off pace in the three to four path then circled some weakening rivals in the upper and shifted to the inside but was no factor. FIFTH PRINCE broke to the inside and settled at the pack of the pack along the rail but was no menace through the race. FLAMING FAST broke slowly then rushed up coming up the hill to be just a length behind the leader and attempted to go outside while being two wide but was beat to the pathing by EPIC ROLL and settled along the inside, then began to weaken in the upper and faded in the stretch.

WARLANDER stalked the early pace outside of MONTEREY BAY, took command along the backstretch then showed the way to the far turn, dug in into upper stretch, met the bid of PADIDDLE into the final furlong and held off the runner-up in the late stages to prevail. PADIDDLE allowed to settle to the backstretch, advanced outside of rivals along the far turn, rallied four to five wide to upper stretch, loomed into the lane then confronted WARLANDER into the final furlong, couldn't get by the determined winner in deep stretch. MY BOY TONY crowded at the start and a bit slow leaving the gate, settled mid-pack into the backstretch, well placed to the far turn then bid two to three wide nearing the top of the stretch, vied between rivals to the furlong grounds, couldn't keep pace with the top pair into the lane but was a clear third. EMPIRE WEST unhurried to the backstretch, coaxed outside of runners to the far turn, navigated traffic behind rivals nearing the half-mile pole, angled out nearing the top of the stretch, ran in pursuit to the furlong grounds and lacked a final kick. MONTEREY BAY vied for the lead away from the gate, took command then led to the backstretch, took an awkward stride while getting overtaken at the seven-eighths pole then stalked the pace from the inside heading into the far turn, couldn't find more at the quarter marker then weakened in the stretch drive. TIME SONG in tight between runners early on, tracked from the second flight and between foes into the backstretch, well placed to the far turn, again caught in tight between foes approaching the top of the lane, dropped back to upper stretch then tired in the final stages. JUTLAND close up to the early pace while three wide, tracked from the second flight into the backstretch run, chased three wide along the far turn, couldn't find more to upper stretch then gave way. NAVID (GB) off a bit slow leaving the start, rushed up in the early stages then settled mid-pack into the backstretch, lost position approaching the far turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and failed to threaten in the drive. KICK A BUCK well placed while saving ground in the early stages,

dropped back along the far turn, couldn't muster the needed response to upper stretch and faltered in the final furlong. NO MERLOT settled in the early stages, was outrun entering the backstretch, distanced to the far turn, eased through the lane and walked off.

DIABLO SHIRAZ saved ground along the inside early on while being positioned in the back half of the pack then came out a bit nearing the bottom of the hill into the two path and raced up just behind the leader then angled out by the final furlong to the outside of ALTA AVENUE and surged late to just be up at the wire. ALTA AVENUE lunged at the break after having a little stumble and rushed up setting the pace along the inside while being pressured by CLICK around the hill, then kept on leaving it's trailing rival behind but was nailed at the wire by DIABLO SHIRAZ. MAX was brushed from both sides leaving the gate and settled into the mid-pack about three wide off the rail then came out a bit into the four path entering the final quarter and made a bid drawing ahead of the rest of the pack but needed more to contend with the top two. CLICK pressed the pace from the two to three path up until the three furlongs marker then began to weaken and tired out shortly after passing the quarter pole.

TELESCOPIC well placed to the backstretch while outside of rivals, tracked three to four wide nearing the half-mile marker, vied for the lead to upper stretch then took command, dug in to the furlong grounds, found more to the final sixteenth and kicked clear late. PERRYLU was steadied back early in a duel for command coming up the hill then pressed it's rival from the two path and shifted up and dueled SMELL THE LILIES heading down the upper and battled fiercely just getting up in the final yards. WITHOUT HESITATION hustled to be prominent early, vied between runners into the turn, took command to upper stretch, drifted out through the lane but maintained a clear lead to the wire. MAJORBROWNIEPOINTS settled outside of runners early, roused six wide to upper stretch, carried to the eight path through the lane, angled back in, fought on late and held well for the place. MELEYS squeezed at the start, recovered and settled while saving ground to the turn, angled three wide to upper stretch, moved back to the rail for the stretch drive, closed willingly to the final sixteenth, was outkicked for the place but held clearly for the show. TOCO DANCER crowded at the start, settled to the turn, advanced outside of runners nearing the half-mile marker, asked five wide to upper stretch, carried to the seven path into the final furlong, chased to the final sixteenth but couldn't find the needed late response. GLASSING off slow to begin, raced in tight approaching the quarter marker, weaved through rivals into the final furlong, was crowded late by BIT TIPSYP, angled to the outside into deep stretch but couldn't muster the needed late response. HOLLYWOOD STARLET prominent early, stalked the pace three wide into the turn, outkicked to upper stretch, couldn't find more in the stretch drive and faded late. ERICA'S BEACH broke in at the start, settled just off of the early pace, saved ground while in a bit tight heading into the turn, chased from the inside to upper stretch, was able to avoid traffic nearing the final sixteenth but weakened late. BIT TIPSYP forwardly placed outside of runners early, chased three then four wide nearing the half-mile, outkicked to upper stretch, veered in approaching the final sixteenth and faltered in deep stretch. SHEPHERD'S GRACE broke out at the start, contested the pace from the inside heading into the turn, gave chase to upper stretch then gave way. SHEZA GO GETTER forwardly placed early then shuffled to the turn, tracked the pace from the second flight and between rivals, chased to upper stretch, lacked the needed response to the final furlong then was crowded late and came up empty in deep stretch. CHASING HIGHS settled two to three wide and between runners, outrun to upper stretch and did not factor late.

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
