EPISIST bumped with OENOPHILIA at the start after being a step slow and raced off the pace at the very back, then shifted up along the backstretch splitting rivals and racing between until coming to the two path heading down the hill just a length behind the lead and angled out smoothly nearing the upper before surging clear past it's foes to prove best. GIMME SOME LOVIN rushed up early with REACHINGFORTHEMOON and angled in from the outside about four wide cutting all the way to the inside through the first turn and forced it's rival to steady after taking command of the pace, then settled back and drifted out along the backstretch to be four wide entering the top of the hill, then rebid heading towards the quarter pole and took brief command again but was no match for the winner. MARBLE ARCH tracked early on along the inside through the first turn and came up on the heels of REACHINGFORTHEMOON and had to steady towards the outside, then settled back a bit into the mid-pack, angled out mid-way through the upper and made a late rally while tipping back towards the inside. EENYMEANYMIGHTYMO raced in the mid-pack about four to three wide heading around the hill and angled out into the upper a bit but just needed kick. DYNA stumbled outwards at the start then raced into the mid-pack along the inside and tipped out in the upper circling a tiring rival but just lacked punch in the stretch. QUITE BAFFLING settled towards the back in the two to three path through most of the race before tipping about five wide into the upper and improved slightly but was no threat to the top finishers. OENOPHILIA bumped into EPISIST at the start and raced towards the back along the inside then tipped out slightly on the backstretch about three wide before shifting back to the inside heading down the hill and improved mildly in the stretch but was no factor. REACHINGFORTHEMOON rushed up early with one other rival and shifted to the inside quickly but was cut off nearing the top of the first turn and steadied back before tipping out three wide through the backstretch and re-bid heading down the hill but faded shortly after entering the upper. TREASURED TIMES raced up close through most of the race in the four path briefly touching the lead heading up the hill before settling back a length or two behind the pace then faded nearing the quarter pole. WEDELIA stumbled at the break and raced at the very back of the pack early along the inside then advanced quickly heading down the backstretch and took command at the peak of the hill and kept on but tired out in the upper.

SEA ISLE CITY well placed outside of rivals early on, bid four wide upper stretch, vied into the final furlong, took command to the final sixteenth and proved best. PRACTICAL PATSY settled inside, rallied along the rail to upper stretch, outkicked late by the winner, fought on and got up for the place. PRETTY PATRIOTIC close up two to three wide to the turn, stalked the leading pair approaching the half-mile, rallied and vied for the lead between foes into the stretch, yielded to the top pair late and held safely for the show. ILLUSTRATING settled mid-pack and outside of rivals, swung out and roused five wide to upper stretch, chased within range into the drive, couldn't muster the needed response to the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the minor awards. EPIC ELEGANCE settled between foes early then saved ground to the turn, angled out for the stretch drive, lacked the needed response to deep stretch but improved position late. SHE KNOWS BETTER crowded at the start and last away from the gate, settled while saving ground into the turn, shifted out for the stretch drive and passed tiring rivals in the late stages. IGNORING ALANA drifted out leaving the start and crowded outer rivals early, settled in the second flight then lost position along the turn, couldn't match strides while three to four wide to upper stretch and faltered in the drive. MEASUREMENT crowded an inner rival at the start, rushed up and contested the early pace between rivals, disputed the pace two wide then took command and led to upper stretch, couldn't hold off oncoming rivals at the furlong grounds and faded in the drive. AMERICAN DESTINY had speed from the gate and showed the way to the turn, stalked MEASUREMENT nearing the half-mile marker then chased that one two wide to upper stretch, vied between foes to the final furlong, couldn't

find more late and gave way. MADISON MOON shut off soon after the start, settled to the turn, angled widest to upper stretch and failed to threaten late. DAGNY TAGGART broke out at the start, void of early speed, trailed to upper stretch, no factor. DREAM WAVE settled three wide and between rivals, raced in tight into the turn and steadied while on heels nearing the half-mile marker, lacked the needed response to upper stretch then came up empty in the drive.

GUY SMILEY sent for the pace at the break and took command heading up the hill then shifted to the inside while being a length ahead of the pack, then drew off in the upper and held clear in the stretch to prove best. STUNNING stumbled at the break but quickly recovered and rushed up to the front and opted to track the pace along the inside and continued on and dueled for the place award with MIRACLE MARK coming down the lane and dug in prevailing just before the wire but was no match for the winner. MIRACLE MARK bumped by LANDING CRAFT at the break and settled into the mid-pack coming about two to three wide around the hill and tipped out nearing the upper and circled around the pack looking to make a rally, then dueled with STUNNING nearing the final furlong marker looking to improve to the place award but weakened a couple yards away from the finish and settled for the show award. ASSERTIVENESS raced up close coming up the hill just a couple lengths behind the leader while being along the inside then shifted up into tracking distance nearing the bottom of the hill and tipped out to three path and continued out five wide through the upper and into the stretch but just needed more. IRISH ADIEU bumped with DOUBLE TALKER at the start and settled towards the back saving ground along the inside through most of the race before sneaking up on the rail down the lane and improving through the stretch. UP BEFORE THE DAWN was bumped by SMOKE at the break and settled towards the back in the two to three path and shifted into the mid-pack nearing the upper before surging down the middle of track passing the final furlong marker and tipping out six to seven wide and making a late rally but just missed by a head. BOTTAS brushed the right side of the gate and raced towards the back half of the pack between the inside and two path then tipped out three wide in the upper and circled VITRUVIAN MAN passing the three sixteenths marker and closed up from the outside of the leader to prove best. CONDUCTED shifted up to the lead at the break and set the pace while coming to the inside along the rail, then drew off heading into the upper and was clear a couple lengths from the pack but was caught and outfinished in the final sixteenth by BOTTAS and settled for the place award. FUZZBUSTER broke sharp and was placed

at the front of the pack and decided to stalk the pace from the two path coming around the hill then kept on but couldn't gain on the leader and finished evenly in the stretch holding the show award. TOUCH OF FIRE was bumped by VITRUVIAN MAN and broke towards the back of the field and shifted up quickly up the hill into the mid-pack coming along the inside and steadied at the top of the hill after getting into position and being slightly bumped by KHOZALITE, then angled out nearing the three sixteenths to be about seven wide and showed some late kick just getting up for the minor awards at the wire. TAKE CHARGE STAR (IRE) was off slow at the break and settled off the pace along the inside saving ground around the hill then snuck up the rail following OSCAR'S HOPE into the upper then tipped out slightly and circled it's rival while surging into the final furlong and drew ahead to prove best. FUNTASTIC AGAIN brushed a rival at the start and tracked the pace after coming up the hill from the two path then surged nearing the bottom of the upper stretch and took command on the outside of THEISMANN, drawing a length and a half away and held sway until the wire. NAMARON (GER) saved ground along the inside towards the back half of the field for most of the race then found a pocket on the inside rail in the upper and rushed up then tipped out about three wide entering the stretch while being asked and started gaining on the winner in the deep stretch but was just short at the wire. NOISES OFF was

forwardly placed early racing toward the front of the pack then settled back into the mid-pack about three wide off the rail and swung out into the upper into the four or five path while making a bid and briefly held the place award but was outkicked and settled for a clear third best. WESTSIDE TIDE settled towards the back of the pack in the three path and swung out widest in the upper about eight or nine wide and made a late bid from the outside improving well but needed more to contest with the top finishers. NEAT was a step slow at the break and raced off the pace two wide through most of the race then angled out nearing the final furlong marker coming into the seven or eight path and put in a late bid improving in the stretch. WALLEY WORLD settled mid-pack early two wide and tipped out three wide into the upper looking to make a bid but was steadied after coming on the heels of a weakening opponent just after passing the quarter pole and weakened after. SCIPIO raced up close early on out of the gate and shifted back, tracking the pace three wide around the hill before tipping out about four or five wide around a rival in the upper and made a short bid just before the final furlong marker but weakened in the stretch. THEISMANN popped the gate before the race, set a pressured pace after leaving the gate and shifted to the inside and kept on until the three sixteenths marker and was passed up by FUNTASTIC AGAIN then faltered. SPECIAL JUSTICE pressed the pace early on from the three path coming around the hill and kept on while weakening a bit to be a length behind and was placed between rivals heading into the upper before steadying passing the quarter pole and faded shortly after. RAPOPORT was brushed by FUNTASTIC AGAIN at the break and was void of any early speed quickly trailing the field while being along the inside and was no factor.

JUST JOE broke out at the start and bothered an outer rival, well placed while three to four wide nearing the half-mile marker, ran in pursuit of TAKE CHARGE BEACH into the stretch, closed determinedly to the final sixteenth, surged in deep stretch and was up in time. TAKE CHARGE BEACH showed good speed from the gate, took command and set the pace from the inside heading to the half-mile marker, kicked clear into the lane, was a bit weary but led to the final sixteenth, overtaken in deep stretch and held for the place. MAHOGANY DREAM settled midpack, saved ground to the half-mile marker,

lacked room between runners nearing the quarter pole, angled out to mid-stretch, finished well into the final sixteenth and held for the show at the wire. ROGUE METEOR settled in midpack and between runners, raced in traffic while three wide nearing the top of the stretch, chased to mid-stretch then angled to the six path for the final furlong, closed willingly to deep stretch but was outkicked in the final yards. TIGER MAN broke alertly then rated just off of the early leading pair, tracked three wide to the half-mile pole, chased TAKE CHARGE BEACH into upper stretch, battled to the final sixteenth but couldn't muster the needed late response. GIOVANNI'S HEART crowded at the start and off a step slowly, recovered then was well placed while saving ground into the turn, chased from the inside to upper stretch, lacked the needed response into the final furlong and flattened out late. OSCAR CHEER broke awkwardly, settled outside of runners to the turn, coaxed six to seven wide nearing the furlong grounds, came on late but couldn't reel in the leaders in deep stretch. ASCOT LAD prominent early, stalked the pace to the half-mile marker, chased between foes to the furlong grounds, couldn't find more past mid-stretch and faded late. ALOHAGLOW jostled at the start, settled two wide to the turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch and did not factor late. MAKER A MARTINI crowded and lost his path at the start, unhurried while saving ground to the turn, swung widest for the stretch drive and did not make a late impact. CAVALRY CALL crowded then bumped at the start, settled outside, coaxed four wide to upper stretch, failed to threaten in the drive. MO QUE broke out and rank early, settled inside, shifted out upper stretch, outrun late.
