

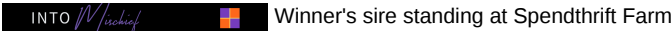

MEDINAH vied early for pace between two rivals from the two path then took command from it's inside foe nearing the bottom of the hill and shifted to the inside and held off multiple rivals in the upper briefly dueling with BLAZING SUNSET then drew clear in the stretch to prove best. BLAZING SUNSET settled in the mid-pack from the break coming two wide around the hill then swung out six wide passing the quarter pole while coming under coaxing and rallied into the stretch briefly dueling with MEDINAH but proved to be no match and settled for the place award while drifting in. ULTRAVIOLET raced into the mid-pack and settled between the two path and the inside coming around the hill then tipped out about five to seven wide into the upper and made a late rally passing into the stretch to get up for the show award. R LAST LAUGH was up early at the break about a length behind the pace and settled back a couple more to chase from the two path around the hill then tipped out four wide heading into the upper and kept on but needed some kick in the stretch to improve. DIVA broke sharp and vied for the pace out of the gate with two other rivals while being on the inside then weakened and settled a couple lengths back nearing the three furlongs and kept on at an even pace but was empty in the stretch. GOLDEN CAUSE hesitated at the break and had a slight stumble coming out

of the gate and was last away, settled off the pace in the two path and advanced slowly coming down the hill before angling into the five or six path looking for an opening between rivals heading into the straightaway, then improved after entering the stretch. VOTING RIGHTS broke with the pace and settled back to the center of the field and saved ground along the inside for most of the race before tipping out a bit in the stretch but made no rally. TATIANA briefly vied for pace at the break then settled into position three wide pressing the leader, then shifted closer two wide nearing the bottom of the hill and put up a brief bid in the upper but faded while being directed to the inside. ROSABELLA GOLD bumped into SHEPPING NACHES at the break and settled towards the back of the field in the two path and continued on into the stretch but was no menace. SHEPPING NACHES bumped with ROSABELLA GOLD at the start and raced off the pace along the inside and was distanced some more nearing the bottom of the hill before swinging out widest into the upper and made a mild gain but was ultimately no factor. GOLDEN REVEILLE raced mid-pack in the three path around the hill then started to weaken nearing the upper while swinging out about seven wide then tired out. HIGH CLASS BROAD settled back along the inside for most of the race and weakened a bit entering the upper but was never a factor.

SHOWA lost his path at the start and trailed early, moved up to the turn then rallied between rivals to upper stretch, vied for the lead nearing the final sixteenth, overtook the game runner-up in the late stages and edged clear. SOCIAL DECEPTION vied for the early lead from the outside, contested the pace two wide to the half-mile marker, took command to upper stretch and kicked clear at the quarter pole, met the bid of SHOWA to the final sixteenth, was overtaken into deep stretch but was a clear second best. BECK'S SAM came in at the start then bumped by NIGHT KNIGHT soon after the break, unhurried to the turn then trailed to the half-mile, improved position to mid-stretch, was no match late for the top pair but ran on to earn the show honors. BOLD SPEAKER settled in the second flight and between runners, tracked the leading pair to the half-mile marker, tipped to the three path to upper stretch, lacked the needed response at the furlong pole then was outfinished late for the show. NIGHT KNIGHT broke out and a bit hard to handle early, settled outside of runners heading to the turn, chased from the second flight while three wide nearing the half-mile marker, asked four wide to upper stretch, couldn't find more into the final furlong and weakened. TRIPLE DARE contested the early pace from the inside, disputed the pace to the half-mile marker, outkicked to upper stretch, lacked the needed response at the quarter marker and tired in the drive. LOOKISM raced close up to the early pace then took back, saved ground to the turn, lost position nearing the half-mile marker, was outrun to upper stretch then came up empty in the drive.

ROSE RULER pressed the pace early on from the three path then shifted up and took command from it's tiring leader nearing the final furlong and inched away in the stretch and held clear to prove best. MOUNTAIN BEAR (IRE) was rated up just a length behind the pace from the two path coming around the hill then looked for some room tipping out to get around the tiring leader nearing the final furlong and duelled with GANAAS in the stretch for the place award, bumping and brushing it's rival and just prevailed at the wire. GANAAS tracked the pace up and down the hill from the three to four path and came out slightly entering the lane and duelled with MOUNTAIN BEAR shortly after entering the stretch looking to hold it's place award but after some brushing and bumping gave way and missed settling for the show. FLYING LIAM settled near the back of the field in the two path and came under urging heading into the upper before tipping out circling ELI'S PROMISE then tipping back towards the inside and having a late kick just coming up for the minor awards. SON OF A BIRCH brushed with ELI'S PROMISE at the start and settled into the four path towards the back half of the pack then tipped out coming to the

outside of the field in the upper and made a rally but just needed more. EXOSOME raced in the mid-pack about four wide off the rail and continued on into the upper but weakened in the deep stretch. IN A JAM dropped back after breaking with the field and raced off the pace between the three and four path then swung out about eight wide off the bend and made a mild late gain. THE MINKSTER raced mid-pack saving ground along the inside and made an early rally entering the upper gaining some ground on the leaders but weakened nearing the stretch. DIVISIBLE BY settled towards the back heading into the first turn about five wide then shifted in closer to be three wide heading around the hill then raced mildly in the upper while coming out about seven wide but surged after nearing the final furlong and came up late closing for the place award. DOCTRINE came into the first turn from the two path and set the pace while drawing ahead about a length then shifted to the inside heading up the hill and held on under pressure from LAZLO then vied along the inside down the lane and weakened a bit but held on for the show award. LAZLO tracked the pace four to three wide around the first turn and shifted in closer to be two wide coming around the hill while remaining in position, then shifted up and vied between rivals through the upper and was in a bit tight causing the rider to take their reins up for a moment and dropped out of contention for the win. FLEETINGLY was a step slow at the break and raced towards the back early from the inside before moving into the mid-pack then tipped out three to four wide in the upper while coming under a drive and briefly duelled with PLANET CLARE in the stretch but closed up well to prove best. PLANET CLARE raced at the front of the pack along the inside then tipped out slightly in the upper around MOON LAW as they were fading and took brief command of the lead before dueling FLEETINGLY but was quickly outfinished and settled for the place award. CHARTIST brushed the right side of the gate while breaking outwards and bumped with SUSSUDIO then raced up around the first turn about two wide and came out along the backstretch while being forwardly placed, then tipped to the inside heading down the hill and tipped back out about four to five wide in the upper making a bid, but evened out after getting a length away from the lead and held the show award. MOON LAW set an unchallenged pace soon after the first turn while shifting to the inside then drew well clear from the pack down the backstretch but weakened in the upper and held the minor awards. TAWNY PORT well placed in the early stages, kept a ground saving path for the opening mile, shifted to the two path with a half-mile remaining, chased to upper stretch, angled back to the rail and offered a strong rally to the furlong grounds, took command to the final sixteenth then held safely in deep stretch to prevail. LAMBETH close up while widest in the early stages, settled in the second flight passing the wire for the first time, moved to the rail with one mile to go, tracked from the inside at the half-mile marker, tipped out and chased GOLDENEYE to mid-stretch, was outkicked by TAWNY PORT in the final sixteenth but was a game second best. HOW'S AL TODAY tracked the pace from the three path around the hill then tipped out just before the quarter pole about five to six wide and surged from the outside and drew clear past the leader and shifted towards the inside while proving best. JAS broke to the front and vied at a controlled pace coming around the hill from the two path while being between rivals and kept on, pulling ahead in the stretch but was passed by the winner and was no match. AGATE settled along the inside in the third flight at the back of the field and took a bed step nearing the five furlongs marker while being bumped by OTHERWORLDLY and kept on to the upper, tipping out slightly and circling SIR HANSEN while making a strong rally and came up late for a clear show award. OTHERWORLDLY (IRE) was off slow at the break and raced towards the back in the two path and bumped around AGATE while coming around the top of the hill and continued on to the upper, tipping out mid-way into the six path and improved in the stretch to just get the minor award. TRIM CASTLE broke outwards towards the front and quickly stalked the pace from the five path around the hill then rallied early on heading into the upper coming up close to the front runners but weakened slightly while drifting towards the inside in the stretch. HIT THE HIGH NOTE was reluctant loading into the gate and raced off the pace at the back of the field in the three path then tipped between rivals heading through the upper and was in tight and bumped with ONE NUMBER

and slightly weakened. ONE NUMBER raced in the mid-pack while coming four wide around the hill then tipped out slightly off the bend and into the upper but was bumped sideways nearing the final furlong and weakened. TOLSTOY broke outwards and bumped CALPABLE then raced up and vied for pace from the four path and continued on to the upper but weakened after passing the quarter pole. CULPABLE was bumped by TOLSTOY at the start then tracked the pace from the two path between rivals around the hill but was empty in the stretch. SIR HANSEN tracked the pace from the inside in the second flight throughout the entire race then kept on through the upper and weakened a bit before fading out in the stretch. BET ON SILVER raced off the pace in the six path coming around the hill but was no menace in the later stages. CARIBBEAN WARRIOR vied for pace off the break while being along the inside but tired out after nearing the stretch and slightly steadied while fading back.

BLESS HER bumped with an outer rival and bobbled in tight while prompting between horses into the backstretch, recovered to stalk close up along the inside, claimed place at the three sixteenths pole, vied with an outer pair for that position into the final furlong and held. TURNER'S CHARM settled two wide and between horses, tucked to save ground into the far turn, shifted three wide at the quarter pole, ran on to vie for place between rivals into the final furlong but was denied. BOHEMIAN trailed in the two to three path, advanced in the four to five path turning for home, sustained progress to bid for place in midstretch then flattened out. DAKOTAH BLUE steadied between horses soon after the start, hung in the five path around the first turn, stalked four to three wide, pursued within striking range around teh far turn then faded between horses in upper stretch. THE RIDER OF BLESS HER CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST KENTUCKY BELLE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE LEAVING THE FIRST TURN, BUT THE OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED BY THE STEWARDS.

FANCY FERRARI was squeezed at the break and was forwardly placed racing four wide around the hill, then surged through the upper taking command and drawing away and held sway to the wire. SUCKER FOR LOOKS settled towards the back of the pack in the three path then tipped towards the inside and advanced up the rail in the upper then tipped out and vied with two other rivals just having enough kick to best them but not the winner. PEARL LAKE raced towards the back of the pack coming five wide around the hill then swung out widest into the upper and brushed and bumped with a rival while making a late bid and just got up for the show award. ZIPLINE broke out and bumped into FANCY FERRARI then raced mid-pack three wide around the hill and angled out near the quarter pole bumping with a rival and kept on with it's rally improving in the stretch but was just short of the money. MAYFLOWER GIRL broke at the front and raced forward early then chased the pace from the two path to inside and kept on but just needed kick in the stretch. PARIS TWILIGHT was bumped by MUNDY SWEEP at the start and settled towards the front half of the pack while saving ground on the inside, then tipped out in the upper to get around the leader and rallied, closing up and holding through to the wire. LEXI V. raced in the mid-pack through most of the race coming four wide around the hill and tipped out slightly entering the upper while making a rally and was well clear from the rest of the pack but finished on even terms with the winner in the deep stretch, just short of the win. CYNICAL HUMOR settled towards the back early on coming two wide down the hill and

tipped five wide in the upper while making a rally and improved through the stretch and just got the award at the wire. BREAKOUT READY set the pace from the inside and drew ahead briefly nearing the bottom of the hill and kept on through the stretch but was outfinished by the top two and outkicked just at the wire for the show award. SECRETLY DELIGHTED was forwardly placed early and settled back while coming six to five wide around the hill and swung out widest into the upper and came under encouragement, then vied making up ground in the stretch but lacking enough to hit the money. LITTLE GEORGIE broke forward early and settled towards the back coming four wide around the hill then tipped out slightly in the upper and vied towards the back of the field but needed more in the deep stretch. WHITE STAR LINE was off slow at the break and raced off the pace, tipping to the inside at the top of the hill and snuck up the rail in the upper making a mild gain but needed punch in the stretch. MUNDY SWEEP tried to bolt outwards at the start and bumped with PARIS TWILIGHT then raced up and chased the pace from the three path down the hill and swung out off the bend and vied while being positioned between rivals and faded into the stretch. RETROSPECTIVE was up forward at the break contesting for pace and was corrected back into stalking distance while being two to three wide around the hill and came under encouragement entering the upper but tired out in the stretch. LAST CURTAIN CALL broke into the mid-pack and settled into position from the three path and continued on with the field into the stretch but steadily weakened. HARD CHAMP raced towards the back half of the pack and came five wide up the hill and was steadied back nearing the top and raced off pace after, then swung in the upper and came under coaxing but was no factor.
