FEASIBLE vied two wide, gained an advantage passing the five sixteenths pole and drove clear in upper stretch. ASHES AND DIAMONDS broke a step slow, pursued forwardly two wide and among foes, chased inside of rivals while remaining in the two path around the turn, then ran on into the final furlong to gain place at the sixteenth pole. VANISHED vied for the lead with an outer FEASIBLE into and around the turn, got headed passing the five sixteenths pole and gave way in upper stretch. ROCKAWAY REEF raced forwardly three wide and between horses leaving the chute, but faded between horses with eleven sixteenths to go, yet regained stride in the four to six path into the final furlong and came again to gain fourth late. VINTAGE RING was void of early speed, crept closer in the four path and outside of rivals around the turn, but flattened out in the five path in upper stretch and tired. MIDNIGHT MUSE chased four wide, then in the three path and between horses around the turn, but yielded. VICTORIOUS NYQUIST broke a step slow and was put to crowded quarters between horses at the start, tracked along the inside but faded around the turn. TAKETHESILVER trailed in the three path and got outrun.

LILTONTYTWOPHONES was brushed between horses at the start, tracked four wide, ranged up outside of the embattled leading trio around the turn, issued a bid in upper stretch and drove clear. FORGIVING SPIRIT vied three wide, got outkicked by an outer bidder in upper stretch and secured place. MOLTO VIVACE led narrowly from a pair of outer vying rivals around the turn, got headed at the three sixteenths pole, gave way while hanging on his left lead and lasted for show. KANT BEAT THE ROCK brushed an outer rival at the start, laid off of the pace in the four to five path before fanning out to the seven path into the lane, then moved up outside of rivals and missed show. NIGHT TIME bobbled slightly leaving the gate, chased forwardly near the inside, shifted out to the four to five path into the lane and lacked progress between horses. HOMETOWN HERO was corrected with a left rein tug out of the gate, reacted poorly and was slow into stride to spot the rest multiple lengths early on, raced at the rear in the three path and between horses, moved out to the six path into the lane and failed to menace. SHAKIN LOOSE saved ground off of the pace, advanced inside of foes in upper stretch, flopped back to his left lead while shifting out at the furlong grounds, but emptied out. OLAZABAL brushed an inner foe at the start, vied two wide and between horses but weakened entering the lane.

DR. PARK stalked the embattled leading trio from the four path, ranged up outside of them as the innermost leader shook free,, bid outside of that one while moving from the five to three path in upper stretch, wrestled an advantage at the furlong grounds, dueled as his inner counterpart persisted and held firm. CHACHING CHACHING sparred for the lead inside of a pair of foes around the turn, inched ahead entering the lane, dug in as an outer bidding DR. PARK menaced in upper stretch, headed by that one at the furlong grounds, fought on tenaciously through the late stages but was denied regaining even terms and held place. SHALLUS broke a step slow, raced off of the pace in the two path, rallied inside of rivals entering the lane, tipped outside of the top pair while closing in leaving the sixteenth pole but needed more late. KNICKS GATE broke a step slow, trailed in the three path, then surpassed a pair of weakening rivals in the final furlong. HE'S ELUSIVE vied two wide and between horses, got outkicked between foes while yielding entering upper stretch and faded on his left lead. DON CORLEONE vied three wide, gave way in the four path and between horses entering the lane, then readily stopped.

SKATE AWAY set the pace along the inside, met challenges from a pair of outer rivals around the far turn, shook clear entering the lane, moved out to the three to four path in upper stretch then held from a late outer bidder. LION OF JUSTICE tracked along teh inside, then in the two path down the backstretch, came under urging while pursuing turning for home, swung out to the five path entering the lane, rallied to issue a late bid outside of the leader but came up short. VALENTINIAN laid off of the pace two wide, then between horses into the backstretch, was called upon in the three path and between horses around the far turn, crept closer while fanning to the six path entering the lane, stayed on before flopping to and from his left lead while diving inside of the top pair at the sixteenth pole, then sustained progress but needed more. LURED AWAY broke a step slow, trailed in the two path, improved position in the five path around the far turn, shifted back inwardly entering the lane and stayed on. CUT THE DUST pressed two wide, bid along with an outer rival around the far turn but gave way entering the lane. ASHLEY'S ARCHER got keyed up while tugging in midpack in the three to four path around the first turn, pulled to advance four wide with nine sixteenths to go, bid three deep around the far turn but faded between horses entering the lane. SPECIAL CALIBER laid off of the pace along the inside, then two wide and between horse with nine sixteenths to go and failed to factor. KINETIC CONTROL broke a step slow, saved ground off of the pace but to no avail. HEDGE stalked three wide, then between horses down the backstretch and faded in the four path around the far turn.

SUMMER IN ADRIANE brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, settled at the rear in the two path, steadied behind foes around the first turn, took the far turn in the three path, swung out to the eight path into the lane, rallied widest to issue a bid in the closing stages and got up at the wire in a blanket finish. NAVY SEAL (IRE) pursued from midpack in the four to three path around the first turn, raced in the bit two wide before awaiting racing room among foes around the far turn, remained blocked in upper stretch, steadied behind foes to alter course outwardly at the furlong grounds, rallied with good energy to offer a bid along with an outer rival in the final sixteenth but missed at the wire. ROTTERDAM tracked two wide and between horses, moved out to the five path entering upper stretch, progressed to bid between horses in midstretch, led as outer rivals sustained and offered bid in the late stages, then got nailed at the wire. DOMINGO laid off of the pace two to three wide, floated out to the six path into the lane, rallied to bid along with an inner rival at the furlong grounds, dueled with that one into the final sixteenth, but got outfinished by a pair of outer bidders and missed in a four-way photo. NGANNOU raced forwardly along the inside, but got very rank inside of rivals into the first turn, steadied repeatedly around that bend, settled in the bit down the backstretch, awaited racing room in upper stretch, offered a rail bid at the furlong grounds as outer rivals did the same, then chased the leaders home. SICILIAN DEFENSE prompted two wide, vied between horses turning for home, sparred in the three path and among foes in upper stretch, but gave way in the final furlong. OBELISK broke a beat slow, saved ground well back, then stayed on up the inside while encountering mild traffic. SAND PIPES stalked three deep, bid turning for home, vied in the four path in upper stretch but yielded between horses at the furlong grounds. SHOPPER'S REVENGE laid off of the pace along the inside, then in the three path around the far turn, moved out to the six path into the lane and failed to menace. PRESIDER brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, raced well back three to four wide, fanned out to the seven path and between horses into upper stretch but made little impact. BRITISH ISLES pursued from midpack along the inside, lacked racing room in the three path in upper stretch, steadied while still blocked at the furlong grounds, never found room and gave way while protected through the late stages. ALEMAN showed the way along the inside, but yielded between horses in midstretch and weakened.
