COPPER MISSILE took back from between horses to settle off of the pace in the three path, came under strong urging while pursuing around the far turn, yet rallied with a gradual gain into midstretch, ranged up to vie for the lead entering the final sixteenth and drove past. FIRST OF HIS NAME dictated terms via a loose and uncontested advantage along the inside, remained clear and well in hand around the far turn, came under urging entering upper stretch, drifted out to the two path at the furlong grounds, leaned back inwardly under right handed urging while getting collared by an outer challenger at the sixteenth pole and got bested. NATIONAL ECLIPSE stalked two wide, chased the clear leader around the far turn, pursued along with an outer foe in upper stretch, tipped inwardly after changing leads in midstretch, took aim inside of the leader leaving the furlong grounds, but lacked ample racing room when that rail seem closed at the sixteenth pole and settled for show. SCHIFTY'S HALOID tracked along the inside, chased turning for home and gave way. GORILLA TREK settled at the rear of the short field along the inside, moved outwardly entering the lane and failed to factor.

ATARAH showed the way along the inside, built a clear margin with five sixteenths to go, shifted to the three path and dug in to resist an outer challenge in midstretch, then held well through the final furlong. DOUBLE JEOPARDY bumped an inner rival leaving the gate, pursued from midpack near the inside before checking behind rivals approaching the backstretch, tugged two wide and between foes with eleven sixteenths to go, launched three wide progress turning for home, bid outside of the leader and from the four path at the furlong grounds but was fended off thereafter. SNIPSNIPPITYSNIP bumped with an outer foe at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, then two wide and between horses around the far turn, ran on up the rail into the final furlong and edged show from an outer foe late. GOLDENAGEACTRESS stalked two wide and between horses early on, then along the inside into the far turn, chased in the two path in upper stretch, yielded in the final furlong and lost show late. THAMES was jostled between horses at the start, trailed along the inside

early on, progressed before shifting out to the six path in upper stretch and rallied willingly between horses. PRETTY TAPIT took firm contact from an outer foe and transferred a strong bump to an inner rival at the start, laid off of the pace two wide and between horses, altered course out to the six path turning for home, fanned to the seven path in upper stretch and stayed on mildly outside of foes. LES IS BEST tugged forwardly in the three path around the first turn before steadyding to alter course to the five to six path and outside of foes leaving that bend, chased three wide and between foes around the far turn, moved out to the four to five path in upper stretch and gave way. RATHER DISTINCT stalked two wide and between horses, progressed three wide once an outer rival faltered with eleven sixteenths, stalked two wide into the far turn before failing to sustain pressure turning for home, and faded between horses in upper stretch. SWEET MACKENZIE tracked four to five wide and faded around the far turn. KANAZAWA leaned outwardly and broke a beat slow, raced off of the pace in the four to two path and failed to factor. PERFECT UNION tracked along the inside early on, chased approaching the far turn and weakened. ITZA KITTY stalked three wide, but faltered in the four path and between horses with eleven sixteenths to go and was done early.

BELLOFTHEBLUEGRASS vied for the lead with an outer rival into the turn, drew off entering the lane and widened under a drive. PRINCESS KALAMOH stalked three wide, proved no match for the clearing leader while chasing in upper stretch and claimed place passing the furlong grounds. MILA JUNES vied for the lead two wide and outside of the eventual winner, proved no match entering the lane, gave way and lasted for show. CANDY CAUSE pursued off of the pace in the four to three path into the turn, moved back to the four path turning for home, but lacked progress thereafter and needed more for show. MIDNIGHT BLAZE raced at the rear along the inside, improved before moving out to the six path in upper stretch and failed to menace. ELOPER tracked along the inside, chased around the turn and faded. MARIPOSA DE PISTA raced off of the pace in the two path, then between horses leaving the three furlong pole and made little impact. NO SHOW broke in the air and was off slow, raced well back three wide, floated out to the seven path in upper stretch and was outrun on her left lead.

TUCSON stalked along the inside, tipped to the four path to take aim outside off the top pair entering upper stretch, ranged up to bid at the furlong grounds and drove clear while hanging on his left lead. FREEDOM'S WAY prompted two wide, vied around the final bend, led in the three path entering the lane, but was collared and headed by an outer bidder in midstretch, proved no match and held place. MUTAAWID broke a beat slow, settled well back along the inside, then two wide and between horses into the final turn, awaited racing room turning for home, rallied in the three to four path in upper stretch and stayed on. SAFE TRIP HOME rated at the rear in the two path, advanced in the three path into the lane, swung out to the seven path in upper stretch and moved up willingly. VERBAL tracked two wide and between horses after getting briefly keen into the first turn, moved out four wide into the final turn, floated to the five path while chasing into upper stretch and yielded between foes. QUATROCENTO got rank briefly while among foes into the first turn, settled in midpack three wide, came under urging in the four path and between rivals around the final turn, moved out to the six path into the lane and stayed on mildly. TRES SOLES set the pace inside of a prompting rival, vied with that one around the final turn, got headed entering the lane and faded. KING CURLIN saved ground off of the pace but to no avail. RAPTOR'S (BRZ) broke a step slow, recovered to stalk four wide, then three wide around the second

turn, chased in the four path into the lane and faded between horses. AGENT CREED raced off of the pace in the five to four path, floated back tout to the five path around the second turn and gave way around the final one. LE GRIS hopped slightly leaving the gate, laid off of the pace two wide and between horses, shifted four wide around the far turn, five wide around the final turn then weakened while entering the lane in the seven path.

CHERE AMIA broke outwardly, raced off of the pace while getting keen into and around the first turn, got shuffled behind a rival into the far turn, saved ground turning for home, but to no avail. RAINBOW RANIA broke a step slow and steadied when an inner foe shifted across her path at the start, laid off of the pace in the two to three path and failed to factor. HANDSINTHEAIR stalked two wide, chased near the two path around the far turn, then faded between horses in upper stretch. TURMALINA broke a step slow and checked back at the start, raced well back in the four to three path, advanced prematurely with a four wide gain at the nine sixteenths pole, bid two wide into the far turn, gained an advantage turning for home, but was headed by an outer bidder in upper stretch and weakened. BIT OF FROST set the pace along the inside, got headed by an outer bidder at the five sixteenths pole and folded.
