VIVE VEUVE pursued from midpack along the inside, checked subtly to tip two wide at the half mile pole, fanned out to the six path in upper stretch, rallied while flopping to and from her left lead in the final furlong, issued a late bid but missed. HOLY FOLEY settled well back in the two path,

inched closer four to five wide into the lane, rallied to bid along with an outer foe in the final furlong but missed and got outfinished. MARKSMAN QUEEN (GB) stalked two wide, then along the inside around the second turn, swept past the leader along with an outer foe at the five furlong pole, vied with that one before shaking free turning for home, but was collared by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds and gave way. SIEMPRE ELEGANTE settled off of the pace along the inside, moved out around the final turn before entering the lane in the four path and between horses, but only managed to chase evenly. ALLAMERICANBEAUTY rated at the rear three to two wide, swung out to the six path in upper stretch and ran on willingly. STREETWHEREYOULIVE pursued from midpack two wide, chased among foes around the final turn and lacked a bid. GIN GIN pressed the leader from the three path, inherited an advantage entering the far turn, led in the two path as an outer rival applied pressure turning for home, drew clear in upper stretch and held sway. TARIFA was brushed between horses and steadied back soon after the start, laid off of the pace two wide before pulling nearing the backstretch, advanced in the four path into the far turn, shifted down and bumped an inner rival while chasing two wide at the five sixteenths marker, shifted back out to the four path in upper stretch and ran on to edge place late. CANDIED brushed with an outer foe then an inner rival at the start, tracked two wide and between horses, chased along the inside while being bumped by an outer rival at the five sixteenths pole, stayed on while hanging on her left lead to issue a bid for place in the final furlong but got outfinished. OCCULT stalked outside of the top pair and from the four path, moved forward to prompt the new leader from the three path into the far turn, sustained pressure turning for home, but proved no match for that one in upper stretch and yielded place between horses in the final furlong. NEON ICON settled off of the pace along the inside, moved out while in pursuit around the far turn, fanned to the five path in upper stretch and failed to factor. DREAMING OF MO was brushed by an outer rival at the start, tracked along the inside, got shuffled behind a faltering JUST F Y I into the far turn, moved outside of that one but jostled with her and steadied hard at the five sixteenths pole, then was eased through the lane. JUST F Y I set the pace near the inside, but faltered into the far turn, jostled with an outer foe and steadied out of tight rail quarters at the five sixteenths pole, got pulled up and steered wide into the lane then was transported off of the track in an equine ambulance.

EXPENSIVE QUEEN (IRE) was bumped between horses at the start, settled off of the pace along the inside, moved out to the six path entering the lane, tipped to the seven path while building momentum entering the final furlong, rallied to bid outside of the top pair in the final sixteenth, took firm contact from those foes while doing so yet sustained progress and forged past. MYSTIFYING stalked along the inside, brushed an inner foe while splitting the leaders to issue a bid at the three sixteenths pole, vied inside of rivals into the final furlong, took light contact from a drifting ALIMARA (FR) at the sixteenth pole, drifted outwardly and bumped that one in the aftermath and got bested by a wider bidder. ALIMARA (FR) pursued from midpack in the two to three path, tipped to the six path entering the lane, rallied into the final furlong, drifted inwardly while bidding reaching the sixteenth pole, brushed an inner rival at that junction, then was bumped by that one and forced to bump an outer foe shortly after, then got outfinished. CANDY BAR tracked along the inside, then from the two path around teh far turn, took aim in the four path and between horses entering upper stretch, issued a bid shortly after, but got outkicked by rivals on either side and put to tight quarters among foes in the final furlong, then chased the leading trio home. UNREASONABLE (IRE) settled off of the pace two wide, gained four wide and outside of foes turning for home, floated to the five path entering the lane, bid between horses in upper stretch, but steadied when put to tight quarters among foes leaving the furlong grounds, recovered and pursued evenly late. QUIETLY lacked speed in the three to four path, fanned out to the eight path entering the lane and moved up willingly. ASPEN DAWN bumped with an inner rival at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, moved to the three path around the far turn before swinging to teh seven path into the lane, but lacked a rally while hanging on her left lead. FREAK CITY was bumped between horses and put to crowded quarters among foes at the start, rated at the rear two wide and failed to factor. EL MEGEETH pressed two wide, bid turning for home, spun into the lane in the three path and faded between horses approaching midstretch. MO SHIRO set the pace along the inside, got brushed and headed by an outer bidder at the three sixteenths pole and weakened. EGYPTIAN CANDY bumped with an outer rival at the start, got wrangled back early on, saved ground at the rear but to no avail. TWIRLING GOOD TIME tracked two wide, then from the three path around the far turn, but yielded out of tight quarters in the four path in upper stretch and weakened.
