ALWAYS PRACTICAL broke a step slow, got brushed on both sides and steadied out of crowded quarters among foes at the start, trailed early on, took the turn in the four path, launched an advance in the five path entering the lane, floated wider in upper stretch, rallied to reel in the leader at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. BELLA VITTORIA sped clear early on, dictated terms with a wide advantage around the turn, held sway in the two path through midstretch, but was collared by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole and got bested. DIGITAL SALE transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe at the start, tracked three wide, crept closer to take aim on the clear leader from the four path entering the lane, but drifted about in pursuit through midstretch, got outkicked by an outer rival in the final furlong and lacked further progress. MY BOSSY LADY chased from midpack along the inside, saved ground and failed to menace. DELICATE stalked closest to the clear leader from the two path, got outkicked by an outer rival while chasing in the three path into the lane, shifted out in upper stretch and yielded. ROSE RITA brushed an inner rival at the start, pursued from the three path and failed to factor. LYLAH RENEE brushed an outer foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path, weakened and was eased through the final furlong.

CRUDO set a soft pace while well in hand around the turn, responded readily when let out entering the lane and drew off handily. DIXIE DEVIL pulled under a hard hold while climbing behind rivals leaving the chute, settled at the rear down the backstretch, crept closer three wide around the turn, tipped four wide to sustain progress and gain place entering the lane, but was no match for the clear leader yet clearly second best. NIGHT AGENT tracked along the inside, chased inside of rivals around the turn, moved out to the four path in upper stretch and stayed on mildly to reel in a tiring rival for show at the wire. HOMER'S ODYSSEY veered outwardly many paths at the start, tracked off of the pace four wide, crept closer with three furlongs to go to be within striking range three wide and outside of the top pair, but got outkicked by an outer rival entering the lane, tired and got nailed at the wire for show. YOU BELONG HERE stalked two wide and between horses, chased in the three path into the lane before getting floated to the five path in upper stretch and gave way. C MAC DA BOSS rushed forward three wide to press the leader down the backstretch, came under urging to sustain pressure along with an outer rival at the five sixteenths pole, but faded along the inside into the lane.

EMBER set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer bidder around the far turn, sparred neck and neck as the battle continued through the lane and dead-heated at the wire. EXECUTIVE ACTION pressed two wide, vied around the far turn, battled at even terms while sustaining the long duel through the final furlong and shared the victory. PROVEN HOPE tracked two to three wide into the backstretch, chased outside of the embattled leading pair around the far turn, pursued as an outer rival ranged up in the final furlong, closed in on the top pair along with that foe late, but needed more and saved show. COPPERLITE raced off of the pace while hung in the five to four path around the first turn, got caught in the five path once again around the far turn, yet rallied in the center of the track to close in on the leading trio belatedly, but ran out of ground and missed show. ENGLISH CHALLENGE broke a step slow, trailed along the inside, entered the lane in the four path and improved position. LIAM THE BRAVE raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, then lacked a bid. COOL RAGS saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. BOITANO tracked four deep, faded turning for home and was eased through the final furlong.

TOP GUN ROCKET transferred light contact from an outer rival to an inner foe at the start, stalked three deep into the turn, bid along with an outer rival turning for home, vied between horses into the lane, edged an advantage reaching midstretch and drove clear. TEEN IDOL was bumped between horses and steadied back at the start, pulled five wide an outside of rivals to reach midpack down the backstretch, progressed tucking four wide into the turn, bid approaching the five sixteenths pole, forged an advantage passing that marker, led three wide into the lane, but hung on his left lead and proved no match for an inner counterpart in midstretch. XAVI brushed an inner rival leaving the gate, crossed over and hampered a trio of foes approaching the eleven sixteenths pole, showed the way along the inside, led narrowly from a trio of outer rivals around the turn, got headed at the five sixteenths pole yielded thereafter yet was best of the rest. JUST A TOUCH was brushed by an outer rival at the start, vied for the lead with an outer foe, shook clear around the far turn, drew off after his rider searched for competition entering the lane, widened under a right handed crop into the final furlong and was geared down with a sixteenth to go. PARCHMENT PARTY was slow into stride and trailed along the inside, advanced two wide and between horses around the far turn, tipped four wide into the lane and sustained progress to reach place in the shadow of the wire. GOULD'S GOLD stalked in the three path, chased four deep around the far turn, progressed to claim place entering the lane, but proved no match for the leader and was caught by an outer foe nearing the wire. TENNESSEE LAMB prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, vied before forging an advantage in the two path around the far turn, dug in bracing for an outer challenge entering the lane, dueled before getting headed entering midstretch, yet fought back to reclaim an advantage at the sixteenth pole and edged ahead. SAN SIRO stalked along the inside, got outmoved by an outer rival while shifting to the three path turning for home, tipped back to the rail entering the lane, ran on taking aim inside of the top pair into the final furlong, but was put to tight rail quarters in the final sixteenth and edged place. UNO MAS BOURBON pursued from midpack in the two path, advanced three to four wide around teh far turn, bid outside of the leader while tucking to the three path entering the lane, wrestled an advantage leaving upper stretch, but hung on his left lead and yielded late. TIME FOR TROUBLE brushed with an outer rival at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside before moving out to the three path into the backstretch, came under urging in the four path around the far turn and stayed on wilingly. PIROLI was brushed on both sides at the start, then steadied out of crowded quarters between horses early on, trailed in the two path, improved around the far turn but flattened out without reaching contention. PRINCE OF POWER set the pace inside of the eventual winner, vied with that one down teh backstretch and faded at the five sixteenths pole. DUKE OF LOVE brushed an inner rival at the start, tracked outside of the top pair and from the four path, weakened between horses around the far turn and was eased through the lane.

ENGLISH CHUNNEL stalked along the inside, then from the two path around the far turn, bid outside of the leader at the furlong grounds and edged past. ROCKY JOY showed the way via a clear advantage, but was collared by an outer rival at the furlong grounds and got bested. THEN was bumped between horses and put to crowded quarters at the start, laid well back in the three path, swung out six wide in upper stretch and rallied to reach show late. BEACH GOLD broke inwardly and bumped a rival at the start, stalked two wide, chased in the three path and between horses around the far turn, ran on in pursuit in the final furlong but lost show to an outer bidder late. ASKARI was bumped between horses and crowded at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, then in the four to five path turning for home, stayed on while getting outkicked by an outer rival in the final furlong and kept on mildly. ROTHSCHILD was bumped by an outer rival at the start, pursued from midpack two wide and between horses while brushing with an inner rival around the first turn, then chased evenly through the lane. CIRO DI MARZIO tracked three wide, then from the four path around the far turn, chased while hanging on his left lead and yielded between horses in the final sixteenth. ACCIDENT trailed along the inside, shifted out to the four path into midstretch and moved up between horses. ROYAL SPIRIT saved ground off of the pace but to no avail. WARRIOR RICHARD laid off of the pace while getting keen tuckng from the five path to the three path around the first turn, took the far turn two wide and made little impact. GOOD BALI pursued from midpack along the inside while brushing with an outer rival around the first turn, then tired through the lane. THOMAS AQUINAS lacked speed two wide and made little impact.
