WIND OF CHANGE (BRZ) broke in and bothered CALL ME MIDNIGHT at the start, was close to the early pace battle then backed out of the potential duel, kept to the inside in a stalking position through the turn then swung three wide into the stretch, finished well, overtook ALL IN SYNC with a furlong to run and won clear in the end. ALL IN SYNC was under hard urging from the start, hustled up to bid for the lead near the half-mile pole, took command leaving the five-sixteenths, had a short lead at the top of the stretch but found the winner too much and had to settle for second, well clear of the rest. CALL ME MIDNIGHT was bothered by WIND OF CHANGE (BRZ) at the start, settled behind the leading group, then launched a bid from the three furlong pole, bid four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest but could not get to the top pair. BLESSED VISION veered out at the start into CHUPAPI MUNYAYO, settled four wide at the rear of the sextet but not far from the front end, chased four wide into the stretch and was unable to threaten but passed a couple of foes late to improve. CAMEO DANCER broke well and raced three deep in the early pace battle, slipped away from the pack leaving the five-sixteenths marker, went clear in upper stretch and widened under steady handling to win clear. JAMAICAN ME was slow into stride and under a ride from the start, circled the field five wide on the turn, raced on the left lead through the stretch, was unable to get to the winner but managed to finish well enough to hold on to the second spot. SILKY'S DANCE was close up just behind the pace battle, bid two wide into the stretch and finished well to just miss second in a tight finish. HALF A BUCK hustled into the early pace battle, was between horses heading into the turn, steadied slightly just past the seven-sixteenths marker, dropped back then came back on in the stretch but was much too late. THE THREE KS hustled from the start and made the front through the early stages with several contesting the issue, was overtaken by the eventual winner leaving the five-sixteenths marker and weakened in the stretch. LOUDTHUNDRHEVYRAIN had no early speed and chased the pack through the early stages, advanced four wide on the turn, then lacked a winning kick in the stretch and finished evenly.
