AVERI EVER AFTER was never far back, was asked for run on the second turn, had little left for the drive and failed to menace. ANN'S STORM saved ground to the stretch, angled out to be widest in the drive and lacked a bid. SHE TOLD YOU SO stalked the pace four wide, dropped back leaving the turn and stopped.
