WANNAWHOLELOTTALUV veered in at the start partly in reaction to actions of TENSAS LUCY in the adjacent stall, rushed up to take the lead before the half-mile pole, had TENSAS LUCY a constant shadow to the outside, dueled with that foe into and through the stretch, lost the lead briefly in mid-stretch then came back on under intermittent urging to pull ahead late. TENSAS LUCY broke inward at the start then was first to the lead then gave way to WANNAWHOLELOTTALUV, was content to press that rival from the outside through the turn and into the stretch, got a head in front in upper stretch but found the rival resurgent, battled gamely to the line but was outfinished. BIEN JOUE tracked well behind the two pacesetters, kept trying to the end but was unable to close the margin. CLEVER RACE tracked in the second flight together with BIEN JOUE and was unable to threaten. TENSAS CLEAR was outrun from the break and trailed throughout.

HEAVENLY DEAL broke well then opted to track behind the pace along the rail, moved up to challenge for the lead at the quarter pole, met little resistance, and went clear before the furlong marker. REGATTA BAY settled two wide behind the pacesetter, did not go on with HEAVENLY DEAL and MISTERHOLLYROLLER when those two quickened at the quarter pole, but chugged along through the stretch and earned the place in the final yards. MISTERHOLLYROLLER hustled away from the gate and grabbed the early lead, took the field through a very slow first quarter, then settled comfortably to the far turn, was challenged by HEAVENLY DEAL at the quarter pole, had no response, and flattened out in the stretch. DEE'S LEGS was contesting the early pace going into the first turn, then took up and backed off just past the seven-eighths pole, was climbing heading down the backstretch while falling farther behind, and chased the rest to the finish.

SALT SPRAY (IRE) was away a beat slow but sprinted quickly to the front, established command by a couple of lengths, maintained the margin through the turn and widened late. DUDE PERFECTA off a step slow, chased close up three wide and finished well but could not get to the winner. ONLY A DREAM hopped in the air at the start, spotted the field a head start, rushed up and regained contact with the field on the turn, finished with some interest but well behind the winner. CREME DE BALI was pushed from the start to get forward position, chased SALT SPRAY (IRE) into the turn, had aim on that one approaching the quarter pole, chased in vain down the stretch, and was outfinished in the late stages. UPTURNED BRIM tracked close up inside, then was outkicked through the stretch. GET RIPPED broke slowly then threw the head while under coaxing to get going, veered towards the inside, got back into stride and trailed the field to the outside of ONLY A DREAM at the rear of the field, came four wide into the stretch and lacked any effort in the late stages.

AUSTYN JANE broke a step slowly, was kept under a ride to get back up with the main pack, swept to the lead near the five-sixteenth pole, dug in under a threat from OUR LAST HALF at the top of the stretch but kept that one at bay while being confidently ridden to the finish. OUR LAST HALF was hustled from the break and pressed the pace from the inside, got a clean run on the rail through the turn, responded when set down in the stretch, finished up well, was slowly closing the margin on the winner but ran out of time. MOPAC TRAFFIC trailed well behind the rest through the early stages, kept to the inside and hugged the rail into the stretch and kept on to improve. SHELBI'S STAR got sideswiped by E R'S MIREYA at the start, took up then rushed up to join the main pack, circled five wide on the turn, came into the stretch with aim on the eventual winner but failed to change leads and faltered. SPECIAL STRIKE hustled from the break, vied three wide to the turn, dropped off the pace after passing the three-furlong marker, and went a bit flat in the stretch run. E R'S MIREYA broke well, contested the early pace from between horses, took the lead passing the half-mile pole then was overtaken by AUSTYN JANE once past the three-furlong pole, dropped out and had little left for the stretch run.

PICCOLO UOMO was unhurried from the break and settled near the back of the pack through the early stages, started to run on after passing the three-furlong pole then got a clean inside run through the far turn, slipped through an opening along the rail into the stretch and finished best, holding off a late bid from EXTRAVAGANT PRINCE on the outside. EXTRAVAGANT PRINCE was allowed to settle from the break, then coaxed to get forward position, went three wide through the first turn, continued to track the leaders from third position down the backstretch, then launched a bid just past the three-furlong pole, finished well down the stretch but came up short at the wire. WEDDING GIFT settled on the rail after the start, tracked the leaders while racing one-paced, lost ground as the pace quickened up front but kept along at the same rate, was set down at the top of the stretch, and produced a bold rally five wide to get up for the third spot. KNOCK'EM OUT JERRY broke well and pulled to the front from the break, tracked RANDY DAYTONA down the backstretch racing two wide, was sent after that rival from the three-furlong pole, pulled even at the quarter pole with a host of challengers, got a head in front in upper stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. LITTLE DITTY hopped at the start and was a bit slow to get going, raced four wide through the first turn, then settled in a tracking position with the second flight, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, came four wide into the stretch, finished with some interest but lacked a winning kick. RANDY DAYTONA made the front without really being asked, led the field down the backstretch and into the turn, fought back when beset by challengers on all fronts at the quarter pole, was still in the hunt at mid-stretch then weakened late. ECLETO CREEK raced forwardly with the main pack into the first turn, then retreated steadily down the backstretch, was passed at one point by SWEET PRESENT, then seemed to perk up a bit, trailed the field into the stretch but managed to come back some and finish in front of the rival in the final yards. SWEET PRESENT was very slow to begin despite the efforts of the rider, was far back through the early going, passed ECLETO CREEK late on the backstretch, then was outfinished by that foe in the final yards.

FIRE IN MY SUL broke well, vied two deep in the early pace battle, then dueled with LIGHTNING TWIRL to the turn, edged clear at the three-furlong pole, opened up when set down in upper stretch and went clear and unchallenged to the wire. DEELITESANDIMSUM took a light bump at the start, then held up at the back of the pack, responded when put to urging approaching the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide into the stretch and finished up well despite racing on the wrong lead to gain the second spot. A THOUSAND ARROWS was three wide in the early pace scramble, came under a drive to try and keep pace with FIRE IN MY SUL, kept on, but was passed for the place while able to save the third prize. RANGO lacked any early speed and settled near the rear, was kept to task late, and passed some tired ones in the stretch. PERICULUM restless in the gate, was a bit slow into stride, advanced on the leading pack down the backstretch, was within striking distance passing the three-furlong pole then flattened out in the late stages. TO THE CHIEF broke slowly then was unable to keep pace with the leading group, tracked from well behind the field, made a mild advance through the turn then tired in the stretch and was not persevered with late. ARKOMA pressed the pace four wide early, backed off near the half, then launched a bid from the seven-sixteenths marker then had nothing left for the stretch run. LIGHTNING TWIRL contested the early pace from the inside, then pulled away with FIRE IN MY SUL into the turn, started to backpedal when that rival shook clear at the three-furlong pole, and was eased up to the finish when hopelessly behind and walked off.
