ISLAND CABANA, four wide into the first turn, took to rating and remained four wide stalking through the backstretch run, edged up then responded when given his cue leaving the far turn, attacked three deep, dueled briefly and put a head in front leaving the five sixteenths, spurted clear heading into the lane then eagerly pulled away under right handed asking. BLUME leaned in and brushed with a rival at the break, corrected and rushed up three deep to gain command into the first turn, set the pace in about the two path while handling some inside pressure, ceded the lead into the far turn then battled on between runners from the three eighths to the five sixteenths, shifted out a bit and came back on to get past REXINATOR leaving the three sixteenths, chased on the left lead, switched over to his right lead with about a sixteenth to go and kept on with effort to hold down the place. MUNCLE, forwardly placed three wide stalking the pace, raced between runners with a half mile to go, could not quicken on with the leaders leaving the far turn, circled four wide into the stretch and finished up effort and got past some faders for the show. REXINATOR vied between runners into the first turn then dropped in to secure the rail leaving the seven eighths, attended the pace through the backstretch run then moved to a slim lead into the far turn, sparred from to the five sixteenths, chased to the winner into the lane then faded in the final furlong. NIGHT STICK, towards the inside and within range, crept closer leaving the far turn then was scrubbed along chasing the embattled trio of leaders past the five sixteenths, shifted out in upper stretch and faded. DOSS, sluggish from the gate, lagged back while saving some ground and failed to get involved.

MYRA'S BOY, three wide stalking a guartet of embattled foes near the half, dropped in a bit and advanced inside a rival past the five sixteenths, shifted back out three wide with aim on the dueling leaders into the stretch, closed in under pressure, joined BIG BOO from the outside with about sixteenth remaining, switched over to the left lead while dueling under a drive and just got the bob. BIG BOO steadied when forced in a bit soon after the break, pulled hard and edged up between rivals into the first turn, remained under firm rating then found a seam two wide between runners and bid near the half, emerged in a duel outside RUNNING MUNNIN soon after, battled on a slim lead into the lane, briefly shook clear with a furlong remaining, dug in when encountered by the winner, fought on valiantly and just missed. RUNNIN MUNNIN gained a slim lead along the rail into the first turn, was shadowed past the five eighths then engaged by two others near the half, sparred to the inside of the winner from the far turn, could not match strides with that one heading to mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. HEAT LIGHTNING pulled clear into the first turn, set a rated pace towards the inside and opened up near the five eighths, remained under some rating around the final turn, responded when asked in upper stretch, drifted out a bit then maintained a solid advantage to the wire while solidly hand ridden. BERNIN TUNE angled off heels early then staked outside a rival through the backstretch, was under coaxing pursuing the winner into the lane, kept on with good energy and held down the place. CATHY'S BOY saved ground off the early pace, gained inside nearing the half, angled out, circled four wide into the stretch and closed steadily. ELIGIO stalked to the inside of BERNIN TUNE, was under a ride chasing past the five sixteenths, failed to kick on past mid stretch and faded. PEYTON'S DAY rated off the pace, raced three wide between foes into the far turn and passed fading runners. TEXAS ADOPTER, between runners nearing the far turn, was urged along to the inside of horses past the five sixteenths and faded. BAYOU BOY brushed with an outer foe nearing the first turn, raced three wide and between foes nearing the lane and gave way. REV TOO bobble at the break, lost ground four wide and failed to get involved. THE HIT KING ROSE, brushed and floated four wide nearing the first turn, dropped inside near the far turn and weakened.
