GET FROSTY veered out at the start, raced mid pack, bore out on the turn and closed once straightened. CAT ATE THE CANARY failed to threaten in an even effort. MAIZ'N MONEY showed speed to the turn and gave way. SHES ONE BOMB ducked in at the start, lacked a bid and was outrun.
