LITTLE DITTY, perched three wide off the leading pair, moved up and bid three deep leaving the far turn, forced the issue into the lane, failed to kick on with a furlong to go and weakened. CATHY'S BOY, forced out and in tight leaving the gate, lost ground four wide, moved up to be within range nearing the half, chased around the final turn but failed to muster up a rally.
