METRONOME pressed the pace, challenged three across on the turn, dueled through the stretch and prove best. KYE dueled throughout and was outfinished in a game effort. OUR PACT broke in and bumped at the start, vied inside to the turn, dropped back, went evenly late and held for show. FIVE POCKETS bumped and was squeezed at the start, advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed well. COPESTHEBOMB veered in at the start, raced close to the pace towards the inside, angled out on the turn and failed to rally. HERCULES N LOVE was hard to load, broke out and was crowded at the start, trailed the field, swung wide leaving the turn and lacked a bid. MAX S bumped and was pinched back at the start and was outrun in an even effort. MEDAL OF HONOR pulled up and was transported off the track via an equine ambulance.
