PUNTO FORTY hustled to a forward position on the inside, switched to the two path for the turn, challenged from outside past the three-eighths pole, seized control entering the lane, put inner rival away quickly in upper stretch and remained clear to the wire under strong handling and a tap of right handed urging. L RANKIN broke in and bumped, raced in range three wide leaving the backstretch, moved into the two path quickly, shied from ST PETERSBURG near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted over to the inside and gained second. ST PETERSBURG chased out of range five wide into the turn, was on the move while angling to the three path, spun four wide into the lane, took aim at the winner but lugged in through the stretch and got edged for the place honors. SLEEPER SULLIVAN tracked the speed well off the rail early, checked behind a rival at the seven-sixteenths pole, dove down to the inside on the turn, kept on for a minor award but never threatened. LEE'S BABY BOY got bumped back at the start, lacked early speed, trailed on the inside through the bend and was outrun. MY MORONI stumbled a bit at the start but was able to recover quickly, sent clear to take control, challenged by the winner midway around the bend, lost command entering the lane and gave way.

SEAGER MAN chased three wide into the turn, moved over to the four path around the bend before getting floated out further approaching the stretch, challenged between rivals past the three-sixteenths pole, battled through the final furlong and edged UNCLE EVCO in deep stretch. UNCLE EVCO bobbled leaving the gate, raced wide near the back up the backstretch, moved into the three path briefly early on the turn, came back out and traveled seven wide into the stretch, rallied into contention past the three-sixteenths pole, put a head in front with a furlong left to run, dueled outside SEAGER MAN in the last sixteenth and got outgamed. LAST CALL PAUL followed in range two wide leaving the backstretch, moved out and came five wide into the stretch, drew alongside the leader in upper stretch, took over at the three-sixteenths pole, lost command at the eighth pole and yielded to the top pair in deep stretch. BAZOOKA CHARLIE chased two wide, drifted into the stretch and weakened. MAXVILLE trailed on the inside into the turn, eased over to the two path before angling out at the five-sixteenths pole, chased within striking distance into the final furlong, then flattened in the late stages. LEGAL MOUSSE chased from inside, exited the turn in the two path and tired. T ONE D FLOUR FREE sprinted clear and elected to stay off the rail, led three then four wide around the bend, challenged by LAST CALL PAUL in upper stretch and folded once overtaken.

MY KATHRYN ROSE trailed in the early going, gained four then five wide on the turn, rallied from outside and drove clear late. LENA LINDGARD raced up close on the outside, challenged around the turn and took over at the five-sixteenths pole, drifted inward while resisting into deep stretch but could not fend off the winner late. BOTTOM DOLLAR bumped leaving the gate, stalked between foes into the turn, chased two wide into the lane, bid inside LENA LINDGARD past the three-sixteenths pole, got floated in by that rival in the furlong grounds and could not summon the needed late kick. ELLIE MOORE (IRE) stumbled and bumped with inner rival at the start, chased three then four wide on the turn, bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. TOM'S STAR raced up close on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, lost a clear path when C PLUM RUN drifted in front, altered out into the clear and could not rally in the late stages. RECKLESS OPTIMISM chased along the inside into the turn, drifted out early on the bend, came back to the two path, angled out in the lane and failed to threaten. C PLUM RUN took control quickly, set the tone up the backstretch, dueled from inside on the turn and lost command at the five-sixteenths pole, yielded to the new leader at the quarter pole and folded.

ROMAN EMPRESS chased from inside, fell out of range on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied into contention at the eighth pole, kicked clear of outer pair with a sixteenth remaining and held safely late. CHOLLIMA bumped inner rival at the steart, traveled near the back three deep into the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in the lane and finished well to earn second. SUPERSONIC FLYER duelled inside IRISH PRANCER to the turn, drifted out around the bend and lost command, regained the lead in upper stretch, fought into the final furlong, yielded into deepstretch and flattened to third. QUEEN OF THE TRACK stalked off the rail, angled inside the top pair and challenged at the three-eighths pole, drifted into the lane, lost command in upper stretch, fought to the eighth pole and weakened. RICKELLE bumped leaving the gate, tracked four wide into the turn, spun six wide into the lane and failed to rally. GETAWAY CHARM got squeezed back early, took the turn two wide and failed to menace. DANCE KID traveled along the inside at the back into the turn, hugged the rail to the stretch and was never a factor. IRISH PRANCER challenged for command from outside, got floated out by SUPERSONIC FLYER early on the turn, lost touch with the top pair with three furlongs remaining and weakened down the lane. POINT AND SHOOT raced widest at the back early, exited the backstretch in the four path, came six wide into the lane and was never a factor. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
