SHORTMAN raced up close three then two wide on the first turn, moved up to challenge in the middle stages, kept the pressure on FATHER DELAY around the far turn, fought head to head down the lane, got floated out and brushed by FATHER DELAY at the sixteenth pole, kept on gamely to the wire but could not get by. KING APOLLO stalked two then three wide early, chased after the top pair three then four wide on the far turn, lugged in at the eighth pole still in close pursuit of the dueling leaders but could not summon the needed late kick to get by. SAQEEL bobbled leaving the gate, sat off the pace along the rail then moved into the two path, came back to the inside on the backstretch, steered out around the band spun five wide into the lane but had little left for the stretch run. IN THE AIR TONIGHT tracked three wide into the turn, angled out and bid six wide into the lane but was no match for the top pair in the late stages. RUNNING SUPER raced up close from inside, lacked room around the bend, trailed two wide into the stretch and failed to rally once in the clear. QUANTUM INNERGY trailed on the inside into the turn, angled out while gaining around the bend, came seven wide into the stretch and weakened. MR. DISRESPECTFUL showed early speed inside KINGS RIVER KNIGHT, took control leaving the first turn, showed the way under pressure in the middle stages, cleared at the seven-sixteenths pole, took pressure from KINGS RIVER KNIGHT again at the five-sixteenths marker, dueled into the final furlong, got forced in outside the sixteenth pole and held second. RODRIGOKNOWS stalked from inside then two wide around the clubhouse turn, traveled on the inside into the far turn, moved and came three wide into the stretch, then finished willingly for the show honors. BARELY FUNTIONAL unhurried on the inside then eased off the rail around the first turn, trailed three wide into the second bend, angled out past the sixteenth pole and widest at the top of lane, then showed a mild rally while driting inward the final furlong. ROYAL 'N RANDO settled three then four wide early, stayed wide to the far turn, and weakened. FREEPORT JOE was rank early and started to climb on the inside then in the two path, chased off the pace two then three wide on the far turn and proved no menace.

SUPERSONIC FLYER dueled inside IRISH PRANCER to the turn, drifted out around the bend and lost command, regained the lead in upper stretch, fought into the final furlong, yielded into deepstretch and flattened to third. QUEEN OF THE TRACK stalked off the rail, angled inside the top pair and challenged at the three-eighths pole, drifted into the lane, lost command in upper stretch, fought to the eighth pole and weakened. RICKELLE bumped leaving the gate, tracked four wide into the turn, spun six wide into the lane and failed to rally. GETAWAY CHARM got squeezed back early, took the turn two wide and failed to menace. DANCE KID traveled along the inside at the back into the turn, hugged the rail to the stretch and was never a factor. IRISH PRANCER challenged for command from outside, got floated out by SUPERSONIC FLYER early on the turn, lost touch with the top pair with three furlongs remaining and weakened down the lane.
