TESOURO DE PIRATA hopped a bit at the start but still came away with the field, stepped to the front and showed the way under pressure from LELLURI early before, cleared that rival at the half-mile pole, led in the two path around the bend, tapped with the left handed midstretch, then remained clear under steady handling through the final furlong and was in hand near the wire. HARMONIQUE hit the inner side of the gate but still came away well, raced up close three deep, chased four wide into the turn, took aim three wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the lane but could not reach the winner. LELLURI pressed from outside , chased past the half-mile pole, rounded the three then two wide and weakened in the furlong grounds. JOYFUL MISCHIEF lacked early speed under coaxing, aked right handed approaching the turn, saved ground on the fence, angled out at the three-sixteenths pole and passed tired rivals. SWEET GEM raced up close on the inside, angled out into the lane and weakened. SHORE LODGE broke out, was prominent early four deep, took the turn five then four wide and flogged.

BRONKO NAGURSKI chased between rivals early, roused two then three wide on the turn, took over midstretch and held HOWBEIT at bay. HOWBEIT chased four then three deep up the backstretch, bid four deep into the lane, fought outside BRONKO NAGURSKI in the final furlong and could not get by. SLEW'S JOY stumbled leaving the gate, dueled from outside, fought to midstretch and was outfinished by the top pair. TOO MUCH INFO broke in and bumped, fought inside SLEW'S JOY for command, battled to midstretch and weakened in the late stages. STAN FROM MALIBU got bumped inward leaving the gate, stalked the top pair from inside, moved off the fence in upper stretch and weakened. MAJOR TOM was bothered by STAN FROM MALIBU at the start, coaxed along early trailing the field, saved ground around the bend, came off the fence into the lane and and could not make an impact. MOMO'S KIDDO chased between rivals, got crowded at the half-mile pole, moved to the inside, eased out around the bend and came three wide into the stretch but lacked further response.

OTRO MAS settled outside a rival, drew closer while angling four wide on the turn, bid three deep in upper stretch, dueled outside BAG'S GOLD in the final furlong and dug in to edge the runner-up. BAG'S GOLD chased between rivals, took the turn two wide, finished with late interest and got up for second. INSTINCT D' ORO sent for the front and took control, led in the two path while getting pressured on the turn, fought with outer pair in upper stretch, dueled inside OTRO MAS in the furlong grounds, yielded grudgingly and got nailed for second. RAGING WATERS chased along the inside just out of range, moved out to the two path but lacked room at the five-sixteenths pole, steered out in the lane and kept trying to the wire. GOOD VIBES ONLY stalked three deep leaving the backstretch, bid from outside on the turn, fought three wide into the lane, vied between rivals in upper stretch and flattened in the furlong grounds. IMPOSSIBLE TASK angled out wide trailing early, rounded the bend four then five wide and proved no menace. DEVIL MOON raced up close on the inside, coaxed along through the turn and tired.

TRAVELIN' SHOW vied between rivals for command, dueled along the inside around the bend, cleared at the three-sixteenths pole, drew away to a comfortable lead and was kept busy to the wire. POKERKNIGHTATVEES got bumped from outside shortly after the start, chased three wide into the turn, came five wide into the lane, shifted in and bumped in upper stretch, finished willingly down the lane and held second. TITANIC THOMPSON got bumped and had his path taken early, chased two then three wide, tipped out in the lane and could not get by POKERKNIGHTATVEES for the place honors. BINGING chased in the two path entering the turn, angled out into the lane and lacked the needed rally. GRAZEN SUN vied for the lead between rivals for a bit then moved inside once clear of inner rival, could not keep up with the top pair into the turn, chased around the bend still within striking distance but weakened in the drive. WHATS THE BUZZ showed brief speed inside rivals then chased up the backstretch, dropped back around the bend, angled out and

came five wide into the lane and failed to menace. GARRY JOHN vied four then three deep early, dueled from outside around the bend, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. HEZASPANISHDANCER got forced into TITANIC THOMPSON at the start, was forced in again and steadied shortly after that, chased between rivals and got squeezed back at the half-mile pole, went two wide into the turn, angled out around the bend, altered in upper stretch and could not threaten. LIL RICHARDS BELLO outquicked from the gate, chased off the pace well off the rail, came six wide into the lane and failed to respond. RUN FOR KIDDER dropped back to last early, trailed on the inside, eased in the furlong grounds and walked off. MR. MACHUPICCHU vied three deep in the early going, chased three then four wide on the turn, got bumped by POKERKNIGHTATVEES and unseated the rider in upper stretch, was caught following the race and walked off. FOLLOWING AN INQUIRY, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED POKERKNIGHTATVEES FROM SECOND AND PLACED HIM UNPLACED FOR SHIFTING INWARD AND BUMPING MR. MACHUPICCHU, CAUSING THAT RIVAL TO UNSEAT HIS RIDER IN UPPER STRETCH.
