GLASS OF JAMESON got bumped from outside early, tracked three wide into the turn, spun five wide off the turn, cleared in upper stretch and drew away. DROP THE BIT chased outside rivals early, went two wide into the turn, moved inside around the bend, tipped back out into the stretch, took aim entering the final furlong but could only gain second. ROCKSALOT sped clear and moved inside, coaxed along on the turn, was overtaken in upper stretch and flattened to third. ROBARANDO raced three wide at the back into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and summoned a mild rally. CHARLEY PRIDE was off slow and lost his path at the start, angled inward, raced outside a rival at the rear into the turn, spun three wide into the lane and also produced a mild rally to improve position. RIDING BY traveled wide up the backstretch, went five wide into the turn, exited the bend in the eighth path and kept on to

improve position. FAR OVER LOADED forwardly placed three deep into the turn, moved out and came six wide into the lane and weakened. DONTGETFOOLEDAGAIN raced up close from outside early, followed two then three wide in pursuit on the turn and weakened in the drive. HE'SQUITE MISCHIEF forwardly placed four deep leaving the backstretch, got moved out to the eighth pole around the bend and tired. HIGHLAND ECHO chased off the rail then moved inside for the turn, lugged out badly around the bend and had little left for the stretch run. MY PAL GEORGE bumped leaving the gate, ran up on heels and checked early, got carried wide by HIGHLAND ECHO on the turn and tired.
