SPIRITIST dueled early from the inside, gained advantage from off the rail in middle stages, edged away around the final bend, continued well off the fence in the lane, grew weary later in the drive and just lasted. BIG REFLECTIONS caught four wide on clubhouse turn, chased the pace from off the rail then three deep to far turn, continued three then four wide on the last turn and into the lane, whittled gap on winner in final 100 yards and just missed getting up. SPIRITUAL ADVISOR settled off the leaders while angling to the rail, saved ground chasing the pace, continued between rivals or two wide and had a mild late rally proving much best of rest. ZAGREUS briefly dueled outside winner then forced pace outside that rival, continued on same path to the far turn, was under ride while three,four then five wide on second turn and into the stretch and weakened. EASY BREEZY stalked early from the inside then two wide, dropped back around the last turn and lacked any late response.

BATTLE SCHOOL stalked early, continued three wide into and early on the turn, drifted out five wide exiting the bend, closed in on leader, reached the front inside three-sixteenths marker and edged away late. KORE KINETIC quickly stepped to the front, set early pace, padded cushion early on the turn, continued two wide into the stretch, drifted out in drive, was collared inside three-sixteenths marker but fought on to the finish. TEXAS WILDCAT broke out and brushed rival, was closest pursuer while slightly off the rail, remained two wide to the turn, tipped out three then four wide around the turn, could not go with the winner in upper stretch then lugged out nearing the wire. BUCKS ACTION widest of all down the backstretch, angled in bit then came back out for the drive and was outfinished for the show. DRAW CLOSE was brushed leaving the gate, chased on two path, came out further in the stretch and was outfinished for third. RAPID ASCENT was void of early foot, chased from well of the rail and lacked needed response. RUSTY BOY reserved from along the rail, remained inside to the stretch and gave way readily in the lane.

RAGING INFERNO stalked the leading group in the five path around the first turn, chased along the backstretch, split rivals going into final turn three wide, took the lead just after the quarter pole and won going away. WHYNOTANOTHERONE brushed outer rival twice going into first turn, vied between in four path, ranged up to leader two wide on far turn, passed by winner and fought for place through the stretch. HOOSICK FALLS vied inside rivals in the three path into clubhouse turn, extended lead on backstretch, on rail through final turn and was passed by rivals, but tried through the stretch to just miss second. KING OF SUCCESS was in the four and three path on first turn, trailed leading group, advanced inside a rival in the two path on second turn, angled into the five path exiting the turn for home, but failed to sustain bid. DISILLUSIONED was along rail into first turn, trailed, stayed on rail through second turn, and made little impact in stretch. SAGUNTO brushed inner rival twice going into first turn, vied outside in five path, began losing ground on second turn and fade in the stretch.

BLESSED ANGEL bumped inner rival at break, vied inside to lead in two path, extended lead after quarter pole and held closing rival at bay. WINSOR GEORGE pressed the leader from inside, got put in a bit tight at the seven-sixteenths pole, shifted to the two path, tipped out into the clear, drew alongside MRSAINTPATRICK in the furlong grounds and wore that rival down to get up at the wire. MRSAINTPATRICK bumped leaving the gate, vied from outside, led through the turn, cleared into the stretch, challenged by WINSOR GEORGE in the late stages and got nailed on the line. BIG TIME COACH broke in and bumped, chased between then took up early, moved to the two path for the turn, cut in turning for home, summoned a mild rally and gained third. INCA got sandwiched at the start, stalked from off the rail, bid between into the turn, yielded to the leader nearing the stretch and flattened in the late stages while able to earn a minor award. CITY OF FORZA chased from well off the rail, went four wide into the stretch, angled out and lacked a rally. IMELDA IS MY LIGHT raced up close from outside, drifted into the lane, lugged out in the stretch and flattened out. SIMPLE MAJORITY bumped in the beginning, followed in range from off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and flattened out. SPIDER JOHN got crowded early, angled in trailing early, driven two wide into the stretch, steered out in the lane and failed to menace. KICKINGIT stalked from inside, lost ground on the turn and faded.
