

MINING DISTRICT raced up close outside the top pair, challenged for command around the turn, fought five wide into the lane, lost touch briefly with the leader midstretch, rallied four then three deep in the final furlong and dug in to edge inner pair in the closing moments. NORMANDY LANDING stalked the top quartet from inside, saved ground to the stretch, challenged from inside in the final furlong and got edged by the winner. R HEISMAN chased four deep early, remained wide to the stretch, rallied between and came up just short in the end. FOR ALL MANKIND set the pace under pressure, maintained command through the turn, cleared briefly at the three-sixteenths pole, came under threat from both sides past the eighth pole and yielded to the top trio. STYLE CAT bumped leaving the gate, tracked three wide into the turn, angled to the rail around the bend, steered out into the lane and further out in the stretch to improve position. MANITOWISH chased four wide into the turn, spun six wide into the lane and failed to respond. VOLDEMORT pressed the pace from outside, between rivals late on the bend, fought to the three-sixteenths pole and weakened. SHARP AZA TACK bumped at the start, chased between early, drifted five wide around the bend and weakened.

# Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

RO TOWN dueled from inside up the backstretch and around the turn, shook free at the three-sixteenths pole and remained well clear to the wire. MANIAE chased along the inside, bumped repeatedly with outer rival early on the turn, continued to save ground to the stretch, then finished well to gain second. A REAL JEWEL chased three deep early, moved into the two path on the turn, kept on down the lane but lost second late. PERFECT LIFE chased from off the pace early on, rounded the bend three then four wide and failed to respond. MIRACLE BALL chased four deep up the backstretch, stayed well off the rail to the stretch and lacked a bid. RYAN'S GIRL chased after the top pair between rivals, bumped repeatedly with MANIAE early on the bend, tipped out into the lane, angled out further in the drive and weakened. BIG CELEBRATION was off slow to begin, chased widest up the backstretch, came six wide into the lane and was never a factor. CHARMED DREAM dueled from outside to the stretch, yielded to the winner at the three-sixteenths pole and folded in the final furlong. DISCREPANCY broke a step slow, chased from inside, ducked out into the turn and unseated the rider, ran through the outer fence and was transported off the track via equine ambulance. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE INCIDENT WITH DESCREPANCY INTO THE TURN AND RULED THAT SHE CAUSED HER OWN PROBLEMS AND WOULD BE NO CHANGE.
