GRAINNE O'MALLEY bumped at the start, raced up close in the early going, bid from outside on the turn, bore out badly at the five-sixteenths pole, churned on down the lane and earned minor award. TIGER OF THE SEA stumbled badly in the beginning, chased three deep into the turn, got carried wide late on the turn and weakened. DESPITE chased between rivals approaching the turn, got squeezed and took up at the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back to last shortly after and failed to recover. THERE WAS A DOUBLE INQUIRY IN RACE THREE. THE FIRST INQUIRY INVOLVED HONEY BUCKET AND DESPITE AT THE SEVEN-SIXTEENTHS POLE. 

CONSEQUENT took a stalking position along the rail, drew closer following behind CASHED up the backstretch, angled out late on the far turn, chased determinedly into the final furlong, drew alongside the top pair with a sixteenth remaining and drove past CASH in the final fifty yards. CASHED cleared in the two path on the clubhouse turn, took pressure from NIMAH then raced on even terms up the backstretch, fought head to head around the far turn, drifted out slightly coming into the lane, brushed with NIMAH in upper stretch, took light contact from that rival inside the eighth pole, carried a short lead over outer pair with a sixteenth remaining but could not fend off CONSEQUENT late. NIMAH away quickly from outside, forwardly placed three wide around the first turn, challenged CASHED on the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, brushed with that rival in upper stretch, drifted in and brushed with CASHED again past the eighth pole and yielded to the top pair in deep stretch. COSMIC HEAT lost her path leaving the gate, trailed in the two path to the lane, moved out and had little left for the drive. JEWLZ tracked four then three wide early, stayed off the rail to the second bend, eased further out and came five wide into the stretch and faded down the lane. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING CASHED AND NIMAH IN THE STEETCH. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS ACKNOWLEDGED THERE WAS SLIGHT CONTACT BETWEEN THOSE RIVALS BUT THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.

ITS A CINCH fought for the lead outside rivals then dueled into and around the bend, battled JAGUAR JON into deep stretch proved best in the end. JAGUAR JON vied three deep then dueled inside ITS A CINCH to the turn, fought head to head around the bend, battled down the lane and was outgamed by the at rival. PLEASE FOCUS showed early speed then chased after the top pair to the turn, went two then three wide around the bend, kept on down the lane and got up for third. MR. MACHUPICCHU raced up close inside the leaders then chased into the turn, fell out of range around the bend, cut the corner into the stretch and needed to find more late. OTRO MAS tracked outside rivals in the early going, went three then four wide around the bend, tipped out at the top of the lane and lacked a bid. RUNKERRY chased from inside then moved off the fence, took the turn tow wide, angled out in the drive and failed to menace. CLEVER CLOVER trailed four wide into the turn, angled out into the stretch and was never a factor. THE BIG CHEESEOLA forwardly placed early, got shuffled back leaving the backstretch, chased between at the three-eighths pole, went two wide into the lane and lacked a rally. GRAZED stalked three deep into the turn, chased four wide into the stretch and faded.
