TUNED TO THE MOON chased the pace three deep, too command approaching the stretch and was kept to her business in the drive. FAIR TRADE , four wide stalking the pace around the turn, was well placed in upper stretch and flattened out. STAR VENEZUELAN , bumped on both sides leaving the starting gate, circled horses on the turn, floated to the five path in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. SWEET NO NO , rank at the break, bumped with STAR VENEZUELAN leaving the starting gate, raced in the two path on the turn, swung five wide in upper stretch and came up empty. THUNDER IN PARIS bumped STAR VENEZUELAN when bearing in at the break, hugged the inner rail on the turn, eased out to the path approaching the stretch and failed to rally. ISLAND DREAM GIRL bid for the lead between horses mid way on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. ECCENTRIC sped to the early lead, remained along the rail, faltered in upper stretch and was eased.

NOEL'S DREAM, forward early, eased back off the leaders soon after exiting the chute, edged up to the inside of a rival near the five eighths to gain a stalking spot, was patiently handled around the turn, closed in approaching the stretch and had dead aim on the leader, slipped through along the inside while under a drive and took over a sixteenth out, kicked clear and was under steady handling to the wire. MISSY'S MAP, headstrong outside a rival leaving the chute, pulled her way well clear into the turn, set the pace removed from the inside, drifted out a bit past the quarter pole, corrected and maintained command past mid stretch, failed to contain the winner's inner bid, faded but was well clear for the place. BEHIND SCHEDULE, brushed and in close at the break, found herself well back after recovering, saved ground leaving the far turn, remained inside for the drive and finished with interest to gain the show in the final yards. AUTHENTICATED had speed to contest the early pace to the inside of MISSY'S MAP, failed to keep pace past the five eighths, chased off the rail around the turn and into the lane but came up empty. LEELINDA broke inward, chased the early pace three wide and weakened past the three eighths pole. COUNTRY ALLIANCE lost ground four wide to upper stretch, shifted in and faltered through the drive.

FORREST CITY , alertly taken to the inner rail entering the first turn, remained along the rail under patient handling, eased out approaching the stretch, was floated five wide in upper stretch, hooked ADMIT NOTHING near the sixteenth pole and narrowly prevailed. ADMIT NOTHING , three wide the first turn, advanced to gain the lead in the two path mid way on the far turn, was challenged by the winner in the drive and dug in tenaciously to just miss. ASCENDANCE stalked the pace for six furlongs, swung to the four path in upper stretch and lacked the necessary response. EARL OF DASSEL lacked speed, advanced three deep on the far turn, challenged for the lead entering the stretch, battled to the eighth pole then weakened. GET LIKE MIKE set the pace along the inner rail, lost the lead on the far turn and faded through the stretch.

WAR MASTER settled off the dueling leaders while well off the rail, edged up four wide into the turn, pounced three deep past the five sixteenths, took over into the lane, kicked away under strong asking in mid stretch then held firm while kept alert. CORINGA edged up early then was patiently handled along the inside stalking the duelers, was maneuvered off the inside leaving the five sixteenths, straightened to be about four wide into the lane, gave willing chased through the final furlong and was clearly best of the rest. MAGIC EXPRESS bobbed at the break, quickly recovered and was nudged up to a short lead, secured the inside then was headed by an outer SWIFTY DEVIL near the five furlong pole, dueled, battled on under pressure as the winner ranged up three deep, failed to kick on leaving the furlong grounds and weakened. LADDIE DANCE flashed speed between foes then was rated back off the pace, checked when in close into the turn, dropped back, angled out to circle five wide then lacked a stretch response.

S S SINATRA broke towards the front despite bobbling, led early then maintained a forward spot inside after being headed, stayed latched to the inside of HEAVEN'S GOT FIRE around the turn, moved to near even terms into the lane, dueled under strong handling past the furlong grounds, briefly spurted clear with about sixty yards to go then dug in determinedly to prevail. BOUNCER , four wide nearing the half, dropped in a path and stalked the embattled leaders around the turn, was put to a ride past the five sixteenths, shifted back out to about the four path in upper stretch, closed gamely and came up just short. HEAVEN'S GOT FIRE moved up from the outside in the opening furlong and put a head in front of the winner, maintained command while handling the inner pressure, dueled on near even terms from upper stretch to leaving the furlong grounds then gave way grudgingly through the final seventy yards. CLASSIC JOKE , well placed tracking towards the inside, worked outward past mid stretch but came up empty. DON'T WAIT UP broke a bit inward, corrected and edged up three wide leaving the far turn, chased the duelers in upper stretch but lacked a serious finish. RADICAL RIGHT , forward while saving ground early, eased back out of a tight spot into the turn, dropped further back past the three eighths then failed to get involved. TENEBRIS prompted the pace between foes, was shuffled back into the turn, angled five wide and faded.

BIG WANDA advanced three deep on the turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch and weakened. JUST THE THING disputed the pace in the two path around the turn and faded in the drive. UMBRAL saved ground disputing the pace to the stretch and faded in the drive. WHATSYOURBIGIDEA , in close quarters at the start, swung four wide turning for home, angled outside in mid stretch and gave way. RASCALLION drifted out leaving the starting gate, chased the pace inside horses and gave way.
