SLAM NOTION sped to the early lead then was soon engaged from his outside by MISSED THE TURN, sparred with that one into and around the turn, briefly lost the lead near the quarter pole, battled back and wrested command inside the three sixteenths, drifted out a bit and eagerly pulled away under strong handling.
