MARTINI MARTIN remained along the inner rail the first turn and down the backstretch, was under urging entering the far turn, swung to the four path at the head of the stretch, closed outside FUN LOBIN CRIMINAL, was bumped by that one in deep stretch and got up at the wire. FUN LOVIN CRIMINAL broke slowly, circled the first turn four wide, advanced four deep on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, bumped the winner when drifting out late and just missed in a game effort. ALVY lacked speed, circled horses the far turn, was fanned five deep entering the stretch and rallied mildly. EL DE LARRY prompted the pace outside UNCLE IRISH, bid for the lead on the far turn and gave way the final furlong. MORNING THOUGHTS remained along the inner rail, stalked the pace and weakened through the stretch. MASTER OF NONE, rated between horses, encountered traffic entering the far turn and was not a factor. UNCLE IRISH, sent to the early lead, stayed along the inner rail and faltered in upper stretch. BONDED, three wide both turns, chased the pace and faltered.

TOPS THE CHART , patiently handled tracking the pace along the inside, was guided outward past the five sixteenths, straightened to be about four to five wide in upper stretch, closed in under a drive, engaged the embattled leaders from their outside with a furlong to go, took over heading to the sixteenth marker and edged clear. SAGRADA RAY , bumped at the break, regrouped and was taken well wide, edged up in hand and four wide outside foes near the five eighths, dropped in a path leaving the far turn, bid to engage GREENER PASTURES with five sixteenths remaining, was floated out a bit while dueling between runners in mid stretch and kept on gamely to the wire. GREENER PASTURES , four then three wide under a light hold to clear approaching the backstretch, dropped in and set a pressured pace in the two path, disposed of RICCIO nearing the three eighths then was joined by SAGRADA RAY, battled with that one into the lane, drifted out a bit while fighting on near mid stretch then faded very late. JOE rated early on between foes, was asked for run near the half, chased on between runners leaving the five sixteenths, shifted out to be about five wide in upper stretch then lacked a serious finish. YOUR ANALYSIS , bumped an in tight at the break, rated off of a foes soon into the backstretch, angled out and lost ground four wide edging up past the three eighths, fanned six wide turning for homed then failed to kick on. RICCIO broke inward bumping a rival and causing a bit of a jam up, corrected and was used wide to contention, forced the pace outside GREENER PASTURES, lacked a punch leaving the far turn and gave way.

BLO BY'EM stayed along the inner rail stalking the pace in hand, eased out leaving the turn, remained on his left lead in the stretch and rallied. WORK HARD lacked speed, was three deep leaving the turn and failed to menace. HEAD OF THE CLASS stumbled badly at the break causing his rider to briefly lose his right iron, rushed up outside horses leaving the backstretch then bolted leaving the turn. WRIGHTSVILLE chased the pace outside the winner and faltered in upper stretch.

SCHRADER , three deep disputing the early pace, asserted himself mid way on the turn, remained well off the rail through the stretch, eagerly pulled away and was put to the whip approaching the sixteenth pole. TINY LAKE hugged the inner rail, disputed the early pace, failed to match strides with the winner, faded but was well in front of the others. NIGHT PREACHER , brushed by WHO SAYS SO soon after the start, remained along the inner rail for the opening three furlongs, was taken to the three path between horses leaving the turn then weakened in the stretch run. FEAR NOTHING stalked the duel, moved to the four path leaving the turn, had a mild advance to the eighth pole and gave way. MISSION ARTEMIS disputed the early pace between horses and gave way in upper stretch. WHO SAYS SO , steadied when drifting in and brushing NIGHT PREACHER soon after the break, trailed.

DIXIE GROOVE settled off the inside, angled out and was put to a hustling ride leaving the far turn, circled five wide with progress into the stretch, sustained under strong handling, reeled in the leader near the sixteenth pole then drew clear. SISTER SUPREAM sped clear early, set the pace off the inside, widened the advantage leaving the far turn, remained clear under a solid drive in mid stretch, could not contain the winner's outer surge then gave way grudgingly. ROWSIE EXPRESS stalked outside a rival, shifted inside around the final turn, made a mild advance under pressure past mid stretch then flattened out. GILDA'S GIRL , taken to rate soon after the start, settled in the clear early, was called upon three wide into the far turn, gained past the five sixteenths, was under pressure chasing into the stretch, stayed on past mid stretch then weakened in the final seventy yards. LACHICAFORTEQUILA lagged inside, angled out near the three eighths, circled six wide into the stretch and failed to menace. DIVINING SMILE saved ground early and failed to menace. MAGICALLY VANISHED , in a bit close at the break, edged up soon after, shifted in and pulled very hard past the seven eighths, stalked inside a rival through the backstretch, failed to respond into the far turn and tired.

AUNT MARGARET showed speed along the inner rail and weakened in upper stretch. SKITTLIEDAT lacked speed, swung wide in upper stretch and raced a bit greenly in the late going. MAE BE MAE prompted the pace between horses, steadied in close quarters approaching the stretch and weakened.
