

MAXIMO MADNESS, forced out by a stumbling foe at the break, regrouped and edged up four wide outside foes nearing the half, failed to go on under pressure mid turn then faded. DATE NIGHT KISSES stumbled outward at the break, recovered and gained a forward spot three wide, was put to a ride three wide between foes leaving the far turn, lacked a punch and retreated.

BLESSED CANDY, within range and under a hustling ride chasing a three to four ply pace scrum leaving the far turn, shifted out and edged up four wide into the stretch, worked through between runners leaving mid stretch, took over to the inside of FAIR TRADE then cleared a sixteenth out, was flashed the crop and held firm under a steady hand ride. FAIR TRADE tracked the embattled leaders while four wide near the half, bid between foes soon after, vied three deep leaving the five sixteenths, wandered out to about the five path entering the stretch, briefly shook clear under a drive nearing the eighth pole, failed to contain the winner's inside charge, gave way grudgingly and narrowly saved the place with a good bob. CUZ UR PRETTY broke sharply and quickly assumed command, set a rated pace three then two wide, handled outer pressure around the turn, responded when shaken up soon into the lane, opened up under a strong drive in mid stretch then continued to eagerly widen while kept to task. DEVIL PAYS IN GOLD chased three wide, advanced inside rivals leaving mid stretch, continued willingly and dug in to narrowly hold the place. SHEILAHS WARCLOUD broke a step slow, settled off the pace, angled out mid turn, came five wide for the drive and offered a mild run while just missing second. SUSAN'S MULE prompted the early pace four wide, moved up and bid three wide outside the winner past the three eighths, drifted out while pressing into the stretch, stayed on past mid stretch then faded. SPENCERIAN, forwardly placed to the inside of the winner nearing the half, dropped back some leaving the far turn, was put to a ride soon after but failed to generate a serious run. STICKWITHTHECOLORS broke outward to be away a bit slow, corrected and edged up five wide nearing the half, was under pressure four wide mid turn and faded. PAY BILLY had his heels clipped approaching the firs turn, raced in the four path the first turn, stalked the pace outside horses down the backstretch, advanced three wide entering the far turn, moved to the inner rail when taking a short lead leaving the turn, was challenged on his outside by JUST A FAIR entering the stretch, dueled with that one and drove clear late. JUST A FAIR SHAKE, five wide the first turn, was patiently handled down the backstretch, advanced four deep on the far turn, bid for the lead turning for home then battled with the winner in a sharp performance. SURFSIDE MOON remained along the inner rail stalking the pace for six furlongs, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn, took aim on the lead in upper stretch and flattened out. HAPPILY DELUSIONAL lacked speed, swung to the six path entering the stretch and rallied outside horses. KENTUCKY OUTLAW broke slowly then steadied when squeezed back, swerved out entering the first turn, circled the first turn four wide, moved up in the three path on the far turn and failed to sustain the move. STUDLYDORIGHT, fractious in the starting gate, was checked when pinched back leaving the gate, saved ground the first turn, angled out, floated seven wide entering the stretch and was not a late factor. BOLD DIVERSION bore in at the start, prompted the pace outside RIGHT WING RUNNER, gained a short lead near the three eighths pole and tired. SACRED THUNDER stumbled when clipping heels with the winner entering the first turn, failed to recover and raced five wide entering the stretch. RIGHT WING RUNNER bore out at the start, made the early lead, hugged the inner rail and faltered leaving the far turn. ARCADIAN, pinched back at the start, stayed along the inner rail and weakened. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the run into the first turn but no action was taken.

TOAST TO COAST stalked in the clear early on while off the rail, was urged along three wide past the five sixteenths, shifted out five wide for the drive but was out kicked in the final furlong. KICK STARTNESS sped clear early, set the pace two wide, clung to command under pressure past mid stretch, failed to contain the winner's outside bid and weakened. SUPREME SONG, three wide stalking outside KICK STARTNESS, was put to a solid ride past the five sixteenths, gave futile chase in upper stretch then weakened. AWARD NOMINATED dropped back and was eased in the final furlong.
