THE MONEY MONKEY sprinted clear and was taken to the inner rail on the first turn, remained along the rail controlling the pace, was challenged by DEVASTATING near the sixteenth pole and dug in tenaciously. DEVASTATING , stalked the winner, had aim in the drive and just missed in a game effort. MINARI stayed outside horses down the backstretch, moved up a bit three deep on the far turn, floated to the four path in upper stretch and rallied. SHINE ON MOON , well placed in the three path leaving the far turn, finished evenly. SKITTLIEDAT , three wide the first turn, saved ground the far turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and came up empty. MOMMA'S LINO , rated back entering the first turn, stayed along the rail in a striking position on the far turn, moved up a bit and gave way. LIKE A DREAM was no factor. IAMDEPENDINGONYOU , rank leaving the starting gate, trailed and swung very wide in upper stretch.

CALL ME MICKY J. , away well, set the pace just off the inside while handling outer pressure, shook clear near the three sixteenths, kept on under right handed asks leaving mid stretch and held firm to the wire. REMEMBERTHEWORD , unruly behind the gate and reluctant to load, broke forwardly and was latched on three wide outside the winner, could not quite match strides soon into the stretch, stayed on to give game chase through the final furlong and dug in to deny an inner foe for the place. ISLAND BANDIT stalked inside, was coaxed along past the five sixteenths, had aim along the rail leaving the three sixteenths and kept on well. PELICAN PIER veered out sharply at the break, corrected and edged up three wide leaving the far turn, had aim when tipped four wide past the five sixteenths, chased on to mid stretch then faded. MONETA AGENDA broke slowly, saved ground leaving the far turn, angled three wide for the drive but came up empty.

VANILLA advanced to a slim early advantage while securing the inside, handled outer pressure while under rating, responded to firm asking leaving the three sixteenths, edged clear and held sway while kept alert. SHE'S NOT A LAD , away alertly, disputed the pace outside the winner, drifted in after that one cleared near mid stretch then kept on with effort to be clear of the rest. TIZ PURPLE rated off the leaders while outside KRISSI N, angled four to five wide while under asking in upper stretch and faded. AGGRO drafted back off the pace, came under pressure off the rail leaving the far turn and faded.
