BOLD FACT lacked speed, raced in the two path around the turn, moved up between horses in mid stretch, closed inside rivals late and drove clear. J C'S BOYS , well placed three deep around the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, went clear near the eighth pole and was out finished. REGENCY TALE , in tight quarters after being soundly bumped by DR. BUZZY leaving the starting gate, swung four wide approaching the stretch, took aim on the lead in mid stretch and flattened out. TAX AND TAGS accelerated to the early lead and was steered to the inner rail, hugged the rail disputing the pace and faded in the drive. GOOD MAN DAN bore in leaving the starting gate, rated back near the five eighths pole, stayed three wide on the turn, raced between horses in the stretch and was steadied in traffic near the eighth pole. ISAIAH FIFTYTHREE saved ground around the turn, chased the pace and weakened. DR. BUZZY stumbled when bumping REGENCY TALE leaving the starting gate, raced along the inner rail on the turn and swerved out near the eighth pole. HIT ZERO dueled outside TAX AND TAGS, gave way in the drive and was eased late. Following the race HIT ZERO collapsed on the walked back to the barn and was transported off of the track via the equine ambulance.

BIG TANKNESS broke inward bumping a rival, corrected and moved up four wide nearing the turn, stalked outside a foe mid turn, worked further out in the course leaving the three sixteenths and responded to left and right handed asking, kept on determinedly to take over outside FIRMANTOWN in deep stretch, switched over to his left lead and was edging away at the wire. FIRMANTOWN had speed between foes then rated back off of the outer leader, steadied into the turn, regrouped to saved ground chasing past the three eighths, eased out into the lane, moved up to draw alongside the leader in mid stretch, gained a slim lead near the sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly. PARKES drafted back early, angled out for the run around the turn, circled four to five wide into the lane, was fanned extremely wide past the three sixteenths and finished well. GREAT HEAVENS , bumped and squeezed back at the break, settled off the pace while saving ground, moved up along the inner rail to threaten past mid stretch, battled past the sixteenth pole then flattened out. BOASTFULLY IRISH , jostled and put in tight at the break, recovered and trailed into the turn, saved ground past the three eighths, eased out in upper stretch and churned on. CLAUDEE BOY , three wide mid turn, angled five wide for the drive but needed more late. BENNY HAVENS eased back off the leaders early, angled out and chased between foes mid turn, shifted four wide for the drive but was out kicked between runners. WITHOUT BORDERS , bumped inward at the break, rated three wide stalking early on, shifted wider for the drive and faded. KOHOUTEK had speed inside foes, rated back near the half then checked when in tight nearing the turn, angled out in upper stretch, moved up some, angled back in and came up empty. BUILT BY KHOZAN

rushed up between rivals after a bit of a sluggish start, cleared off into the turn, set the pace towards the inside, wandered outward when joined near mid stretch and tired.

MAJORCA , three wide the first turn, advanced to the lead mid way on the backstretch, dueled two wide on the far turn then drew away under energetic urging. DERBYNESS stalked the pace well off the rail, circled the far turn three wide, was in a striking position in upper stretch and flattened out. SURFSIDE MOON , a bit rank at the start, swung four wide entering the stretch and lacked a rally. HITTHEROADJAK , a forward factor in the two path between horses on the first turn, moved to the inner rail leaving the backstretch, dueled with the winner around the far turn then tired. STATESMAN , three wide the first turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and was always outrun. VANCE SCHOLARS showed speed along the inner rail, faltered after six furlongs and was eased.

MY MISS MO bobbed at the break, quickly recovered, advanced three wide into the first turn, raced forwardly outside the leader down the backstretch, moved up in the two path between horses to challenge for the lead mid way on the far turn, battled inside JUMPING THE GUN through the stretch and drove clear late. JUMPING THE GUN raced in the two path between horses on the first turn, stalked outside rivals down the backstretch, advanced three deep to bid for the lead outside the winner midway on the far turn, dueled with that one through the stretch and finished gamely. A. P.'S GIRL , three wide the first turn, circled the far turn three wide, floated to the four path entering the stretch and finished evenly. MAJESTIC LUCIA broke slowly and trailed to the far turn, swung to the four path on the bend, floated to the five path in upper stretch and passed tired foes. MISS FULTON GAL remained along the rail chasing the pace for six furlongs, moved to the two path approaching the stretch and faded inside horses. HOLLY'S HOLIDAY , in mid pack down the backstretch, came into the stretch in the two path between horses and lacked a rally. BRAKEN POPPA stumbled leaving the starting gate, was not an early factor, raced three deep the far turn, floated to the five path in upper stretch and lacked a rally. IVY GIRL stumbled badly at the break then was not a factor. SAVOR IT made the early lead and was taken to the inner rail, remained along the rail setting the pace to the three eighths pole then faltered in upper

stretch.

NO MORE CALLS , soundly bumped at the break, settled off the pace and about two wide, gained past the three eighths, swung out five wide into the lane, made a grinding run outside rivals, took over in deep stretch and prevailed. CLOSE THE GATE , bumped at the break, regrouped and edged up four wide to a stalking spot, bid three deep mid turn, gained a clear advantage under pressure in upper stretch, was engaged from both sides heading to the sixteenth pole, dueled and continued on gamely. TARTABULL tracked off the inside, edged up and bid between rivals mid turn, dropped to the inside for the drive and rebid near mid stretch, sparred with CLOSE THE GATE past mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. STREET PARTY , in the clear and within range, circled four wide with a run nearing the stretch, took aim, failed to sustain leaving the three sixteenths and faded. BALA DE PLATA sped to the front, set the pace two wide, was joined by outer foes mid turn, vied to the head of the lane and weakened. MAKE IT QUICK prompted the pace inside, failed to kick on leaving the three eighths and faltered.
