THOSEWERETHEDAYS was sent up outside a rival to take over in the opening furlong, cleared into the turn then dropped in to set the pace, responded when shoved along and spurted away into the lane, kept on under left handed asking past mid stretch and held firm to the wire. DANCING DENAE broke alertly and held a brief early advantage, rated back off the winner into the turn and stalked towards the inner rail, came under a ride heading towards the stretch, eased out soon into the lane and finished gamely to slowly gain. NO MORE CALLS broke a bit slow, quickly recovered and edged up three wide approaching the turn, dropped in a path and bid outside the winner mid turn, could not quicken with that one while under a ride into the stretch, stayed willingly to mid stretch and faded. ZIMBA, sluggish towards the inside, failed to respond. BABY BOBBY broke slowly, veered out soon after, was urged off the inside after being corrected, failed to kick on leaving the five sixteenths and retreated.

ROWSIE EXPRESS rated off the pace, angled six wide making some progress in upper stretch, altered in past mid stretch then flattened out. MISCHIEF IN MOTION, well placed in the clear stalking the early duel, failed to go on under a ride leaving the three eighths and tired. DIVINE WORKS vied outside RED HAT HANNA through the opening half mile, put a head in front leaving the far turn, failed to contain then winner's outside move, faltered leaving the quarter pole and was being eased late. SHINE ON MOON, wide around the turn, floated to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied mildly. BABY BLOCKS circled foes on the turn chasing the pace, came into the lane in the four path, bid for the lead near the eighth pole then gave way. WATCH ME DISAPPEAR disputed the pace outside SOMETHINGWONDERFUL on the turn, drifted to the four path turning for home and gave way the final furlong. LILLY SIMONE saved ground on the turn, hugged the inner rail in upper stretch, checked lacking room approaching the eighth pole, altered course and ran out of time. NOQUESTIONABOUTIT hugged the inner rail, chased the pace and weakened. PINOTSLILGIRL, checked near the five eighths pole, circled the turn five wide, floated to the six path in upper stretch, advanced to the eighth pole then gave way. #### Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

HOT ON YOUR HEELS stalked the pace, circled the turn three wide, floated to the four path at the head of the lane, closed steadily and was up late. BAND TOUR worked between horses in upper stretch, moved to the eight path near the sixteenth pole, rallied and drifted out late. ALL FRUITS RIPE stayed along the inner rail on the turn, moved to the three path in mid stretch and rallied while lugging in. SALVO TRIGGER stalked the pace three wide on the turn, floated to the four path entering the stretch gained the lead in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. MOONLIT FROST broke slowly, stayed along the inner rail on the turn, remained inside horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. SPY WARS raced inside horses, steadied near the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. ROCK BULLET lacked speed, swung to the nine path in mid stretch and passed tired horses. FURIOUS GEORGE, between horses on the turn, moved to the inner rail approaching the stretch, angled out, worked between rivals in the drive and failed to rally. VERNOR'S JUNCTION showed speed along the inner rail and weakened. WARRIOR'S NOTION prompted the pace outside VERNON'S JUNCTION and weakened the final furlong. ROYAL FLUSH HEARTS, five deep on the turn, gave way. CHAPIN ELEVEN refused to break when acting up at the start. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the start but no action was taken.
