STELLA MARS , moved to the inside entering the first turn, remained along the rail under patient rating, advanced through a narrow opening along the rail in upper stretch, continued her bid inside horses and gained the lead approaching the finish. SHE IS WISKY saved ground the first turn, inched up in the two path leaving the far turn, remained near the two path through the stretch, bid for the lead late and finished gamely outside the winner. ANOINT lacked speed, was in the two path leaving the backstretch, angled out turning for home, floated to the seven path in mid stretch and rallied between horses. INANNA'S QUEST , unhurried early, raced in the three path leaving the far turn, angled out a bit and flattened out between horses. MAXIMO MADNESS angled to the eight path in mid stretch and showed a late gain. WHITE LILACS went clear on the backstretch, saved ground the far turn, moved out for the drive and gave way. FIVECOMMATWO stalked the pace three deep for six furlongs, was well positioned in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. CAIRO



STREET showed speed, raced outside WHITE LILACS on the far turn and gave way. STAGE CALL stayed inside horses throughout and gave way. SKIP THRU DA FIRE was outrun.

ROSIEONTHERIVER , three deep around the first turn, tracked outside through the backstretch run, moved up under a ride and bid three deep nearing the five sixteenths, battled outside GOLDEN SWORD before poking a head in front approaching the stretch, shook clear under a stout drive in upper stretch then steadily widened while kept to task. GOLDEN SWORD cleared early and set a rated pace towards the inner rail, dug in when confronted by a pair of rivals leaving the three eighths, sparred to the inside of the winner into the lane, failed to match strides heading to mid stretch but continued with good effort to the wire. CHICKIN LICKIN stalked inside, was under a hustling ride leaving the far turn, shifted out for the drive but failed to generate a serious rally. REPLY stumbled at the break, regrouped and settled in last while towards the inside, was under pressure past the five sixteenths, remained inside into the lane but failed to muster up a run. CLEMENTINE HUNTER prompted the pace two wide, moved up under asking and engaged the leader leaving the far turn, vied between runners near the five sixteenths, failed to kick on entering the lane and weakened. MISCHIEF IN MOTION , keen between rivals around the first turn and into the backstretch, drafted back a few lengths near the five eighths, was under pressure around the final turn, shifted wide and faded.

MIKE THE BOMB , rated behind horses for six furlongs while near the inner rail, moved to the five path and split rivals in upper stretch, went clear, drifted in and held sway under urging. FIGHTNOMOREFOREVER , along the inner rail the first turn, moved out on the far turn, swung to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied outside horses. FRIDAYSWITHMURRAY , four wide the first turn, rated outside horses, was three wide mid way on the far turn, angled to the six path in upper stretch and rallied mildly. MORTAL SIN , well placed between horses throughout, had aim on the lead in mid stretch and flattened out. JUST FOR GIGGLES swung very wide in upper stretch and passed tired horses. WHENIGETTOHEAVEN stalked the pace three wide, was pushed along chasing the embattled leaders approaching the stretch, leveled off under left handed asks past the three sixteenths, moved up and drew alongside DETERMINED KINGDOM nearing the sixteenth pole, switched over to his left lead when taking command and floated out in deep stretch then was edging away at the wire. DETERMINED KINGDOM prompted the pace outside TIDEWATER, moved in hand to engage that one past the three eighths, struck the top in upper stretch, was roused clear past the three sixteenths, dug in when confronted nearing the sixteenth marker, duelled while drifting out and gave way grudgingly. HAD TO HAVE HIM was a bit unruly behind the gate and reluctant to load, pulled his way forward between rivals nearing the turn, drafted back a bit mid turn, shifted out four wide into the lane, edged up past the sixteenth marker, altered outside drifting rivals and rallied.
