PRINCESS CLEMMIE disputed the early pace outside LADY LEMONCELLO, put that one away inside the eighth pole under confident handling, was hooked on her outside by SOMME RIVER near the sixteenth pole and responded to left hand urging to prevail. SOMME RIVER , saved ground the first turn, moved up between horses the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch, bid for the lead near the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. SKITTLIEDAT , along the inner rail down the backstretch, moved out on the far turn, worked between horses and rallied mildly. MOON BABY , rank at the break, raced between horses in the stretch, passed tired rivals and her rider dropped her crop near the sixteenth pole. BRAND NEW DANCE , a forward factor outside horses down the backstretch, chased the pace and weakened. JAM'S PAPER MOON circled the far turn three wide, floated very wide in upper stretch and lacked a rally. LUCKY PARTNERS chased the pace and weakened. LADY LEMONCELLO remained along the inner rail, disputed the pace and weakened the final furlong. NAPOLITAN was outrun. VALERIE STREET , four wide the first turn, was used chasing the pace down the backstretch, drifted to the inner rail on the far turn and tired.

NEOLITHICA sped to the front and handled early inner pressure from I CAN DO IT, spurted clear heading to the half and was nursed along two wide around the turn, came three wide into the lane, widened under a couple of asks in mid stretch then held firm while steadily hand ridden late. I CAN DO IT sped up to the inside of the winner leaving the chute and forced the pace past the five eighths, was rated back near the half then chased, remained inside gathering momentum leaving the three sixteenths and finished up willingly to gain the place. PEYTON ELIZABETH broke on top despite a bobble, regrouped and settled four wide, advanced three deep mid turn, chased past mid stretch but came up empty late. FAINOR'S FILETS was rated off the pace and raced three wide mid turn, angled six wide in the drive and offered a belated response. MAVILUS broke a step slow, lagged inside, saved ground into the stretch but failed to muster up a rally. PHOTO FINISH stalked the pace off the inside, was put to a hustling ride leaving the three eighths, chased between rivals past the five sixteenths then weakened nearing mid stretch. ISABELLA'S GLORY lacked speed, raced off the inside and failed to menace.

NOBLE JON , never far back, raced between horses around the turn, closed outside VAMOS VIEJO, overtook that one inside the sixteenth pole then held sway. CACTUS bore out bumping FREESTANDING at the start, was bumped by LOUISIANIMAL soon after the break, worked between horses in the stretch, moved outside NOBLE JON late and rallied. SOUTHERN HORSE (ARG) , pinched back leaving the starting gate, swung to the six path in upper stretch and rallied outside horses. COMPETITIVE SAINT , wide on the turn, passed tired rivals. VAMOS VIEJO sped to the front, opened up on the turn, was in hand in upper stretch and tired late. LOUISIANIMAL bumped CACTUS when bearing out leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn and gave way in the drive. FREESTANDING , bumped at the start, chased pace off rail and weakened. TENAX , steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch, stayed along the inner rail throughout and weakened. MONSTER MASON , ,outrun ,swung wide in upper stretch.

PLEASE MARRY ME had speed inside then was rated back off the leader, stayed close while towards the rail, eased back a bit leaving the far turn then angled out, rebid between foes approaching the lane, spurted clear under a drive past the three sixteenths, dug in when collared by an outer PUT A ROCK ON IT, lost command inside the sixteenth pole, battled back gamely and put a nose in front at the wire. PUT A ROCK ON IT , taken back soon after the break, settled in last through the backstretch run, angled out leaving the far turn and was put to pressure, rolled up five wide outside rivals into the lane, closed in and drew alongside the winner leaving mid stretch, dueled, gained a narrow advantage in deep stretch but just failed to hold the edge.

DRIFTING , reluctant to load into the starting gate, bumped with FONTABELLE at the start, sped to the early lead, saved ground around and weakened late. KOBE'S HOPE , under urging outside horses mid way on the turn, advanced in upper stretch then flattened out. FAHNEE , rated along the inner rail down the backstretch and around the turn, angled out in upper stretch and was no factor. FONTABELLE , bumped on both sides leaving the starting gate, was no factor and got caught in tight quarters near the eighth pole. TIERRA SANTA remained along the inner rail stalking the pace and gave way in the drive. WHISKEY BREW stayed along the inner rail on the turn and gave way.
