ELUSIVE IMAGE stayed along the inner rial stalking the pace, angled to the three path in mid stretch, took command near the sixteenth pole and drew off. BABY OSCAR remained along the inner rail, had to wait for room in upper stretch, moved off the rail in mid stretch and rallied. HAPPY JAUNT prompted the pace outside ZAPATA and faded late. GO TO THE KINGDOM , five wide approaching the first turn, lacked speed, floated six deep leaving the far turn and had a mild gain outside horses. COCKTAILS AT NOON lacked speed, raced five wide entering the stretch, drifted in in mid stretch and failed to rally. ADDICTED TO YOU raced in mid pack and was checked lacking room in mid stretch. ZAPATA (IRE) made the early lead, set the pace along the inner rail and gave way the final sixteenth of a mile. TOP BLOOD ,steadied entering the first turn, raced in the four path on both turns and gave way.

SOUPER CRUNCHY drifted in at the break tightening foes, corrected and edged up to prompt the pace outside LIAM'S THE GREAT, came under a ride leaving the far turn, bid to engage soon into the lane, wrested command past the three sixteenths, drifted in when clearing leaving the furlongs then kicked away under a drive. PREACHA MEYERS , off last when having his head turned at the break, steadied in the initial strides, regrouped and moved up off the rail into the first turn, took closer order three wide heading to the half, chased outside the winner entering the lane, drifted in on his left lead in mid stretch, switched over to the correct lead and finished up gamely to nab the place to the inside of LIAM'S THE GREAT. LIAM'S THE GREAT quickly cleared and dropped in towards the inner rail to set the pace, was scrubbed along holding the advantage into the lane, battled to the inside of the winner leaving the three sixteenths, altered out leaving mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. KENTUCKY GO GO stalked inside, took closer order nearing the far turn, was under heavy pressure pursuing into the lane, lacked a punch in mid stretch and faded. BETTER WATCH IT , in close soon after the break, recovered and settled off the inside, was under a hearty ride exiting the far turn but failed to muster up a rally. An objection by the rider of LIAM'S THE GREAT against the winner alleging interference leaving mid stretch was not allowed.

STEWBALL broke forward despite a bump, cleared soon after then took to rating and handled outer pressure into and around the turn, shook clear after being set down in upper stretch then was unwavering through the final furlong while kept to a drive. LUCA MACHINE broke inward bumping with the winner, straightened and edged up leaving the five eighths to press, drifted out a path soon into the lane, corrected to pursue through the final three sixteenths and kept on gamely to narrowly save the place. JESTER SANG brushed with an inner foe and was shuffled back from between rivals in the opening furlong, sat behind foes leaving the far turn then dropped inside into the lane, steadied when lacking room leaving the three sixteenths, altered out in the final furlong and finished with good energy. LONG STRAW , off the pace, raced three wide into the lane, was forced in some near mid stretch, split foes and continued on with effort. CHIMNEY SWEEP , brushed with JESTER SANG when a bit headstrong working between foes early on, bumped with an outer foe into the turn, stalked between horses mid turn, angled five wide to loom soon into the stretch, swerved outward multiple times after being asked left handed and faded. FAROOQ , four wide when forward nearing the turn, exchanged a bumped with CHIMNEY SWEEP entering the turn, stalked three deep past the three eighths, swung six wide for the drive and faded. HIPS CHAMP broke a bit outward then rated back off heels when correcting, advanced inside into the turn, eased out chasing into the stretch, failed to kick on through the final furlong and faded.
