MORNING THOUGHTS, confidently handled four wide stalking outside the leader, moved to engage leaving the far turn, took over past the five sixteenths, opened up after being put to a stiff drive in upper stretch then held firm while kept to task. LONELY RIDE broke a step slow, lagged off the pace while saving ground, eased out into the stretch, worked between foes near mid stretch and kept on gamely to steadily cut into the winner's margin. ADMIT NOTHING settled well off the inside, gained five wide outside a rival and under a hustling ride into the stretch, flattened out some late but managed to save the show. STATES UNITED dropped in some entering the first turn and stalked the pace, shifted four wide under a solid ride past the five sixteenths, chased to the inside of ADMIT NOTHING but failed to seriously kick on. ARMANDO R, coaxed along into the first turn, saved ground well off the early pace, gathered some steam and advanced between rivals into the lane, leveled off under some right handed asks, shifted in towards the rail, sustained while being flashed the crop, took over a sixteenth out and drew clear. MASTER OF NONE, four wide between runners through about the opening three furlongs, dropped in a bit and edged up into the far turn, drew alongside the leader after six furlongs, wrested command soon into the lane, shook clear under a drive, wandered out a bit near mid stretch, failed to deny the winner's charge but kept on gamely to be well clear of the rest. MAILMAN MONEY bobbled at the break, vied inside around the first turn then eased back off the leader soon into the backstretch, stalked towards the rail, steadied when in tight with three and a half furlongs remaining then weakened.

NOAH CHANCE prompted the pace two to three wide, went on the attack soon into the lane, kicked clear heading to mid stretch, wandered out a bit then held firm under a drive. CACTUS, three wide under firm rating into the turn, circled four wide into the stretch, had his rider drop the crop with about three sixteenths remaining, kept on with good energy and nabbed the place in the final yards. JOLLY BOSS saved ground, eased out in upper stretch, made progress between runners near mid stretch, gave willing chase from there but was edged out for second. WATCH OUT WORLD sped clear early, set the pace towards the inner rail, was collared in upper stretch, stayed on with good effort to the sixteenth pole then faded late.
